- I want to thank the committee members for their significant work engaging British Columbians in the development of these recommendations.
- The Agricultural Land Commission plays a key role in protecting the Agricultural Land Reserve.
- As an administrative tribunal, arm's length from government, their mandate is to preserve agricultural land while encouraging farming.
- British Columbians are passionate about the ALR. I've heard from many people over the past year about how we can revitalize the ALR and ALC and protect farming as a livelihood for future generations.

- This independent report is another important contribution to the conversation.
- The ALR was an incredible, innovative idea when it was enacted in the 1970's, but at that time, no one could have foreseen some of the current pressures that the reserve is facing.
- By revitalizing the ALR and the ALC, we will make it easier and more efficient for the ALC to fulfill their mandate of preserving agriculture land in B.C. and encouraging farming and ranching.

ALR key facts

- The ALR includes 46,159 square kilometres of B.C. that are preserved for agricultural use, which is equivalent to just 5 per cent of B.C.'s total land base.
- Land in the ALR falls into one of seven soil classes, ranging from Class 1 (wide range of crops can be grown without difficulty) to Class 7 (unsuitable for soil-based agriculture or sustained grazing, suitable for barns, greenhouses and processing facilities).
- Currently, 10% of the land in the ALR produces 85% of B.C.'s farm receipts (and 3% of ALR land in the South Coast region produces 65% of the province's farm receipts).
- By Agricultural Land Reserve region:
 - Island region - 2% of ALR, 6% of farm receipts
 - South Coast region - 3% of ALR, 65% of farm receipts
 - Okanagan region - 5% of ALR, 14% of farm receipts
 - Kootenay region - 8% of ALR, 2.5% of farm receipts
 - Interior region - 31% of ALR, 4.5% of farm receipts
 - North region - 50% of ALR, 8% of farm receipts
