Hi Brian,

As discussed on the phone, Target Marine has put in a request to become federally registered. We have been working with them and reviewing their submitted QMP document.

On November 4, 2011 we conducted a Construction and Sanitation (Sch I and II) inspection on their facility and found overall the facility to be in excellent condition however there were a few minor comments. The concerns were the following

- Brush in the back that needed clearing
- Floor joint not sealed.
- protective light covering was glass
- lights in storage area were not covered
- no floor drain or sill in the washroom

- cooler in processing room is > 4C
- protective clothing should be worn prior to entering the processing room.

A recent inspection conducted on the week of Nov 28 - Dec 3, 2011 confirmed that all the deficiencies were corrected. The brush was cleared, the floor wall joints were caulked, the lights in the processing room are now shatterproof, lights in the storage room now have a shatterproof guard over top, a sill was installed in the bathroom, the cooler was set at a lower temperature 3C and the rack for lab coats is now mounted outside of the processing room.

The CFIA is willing to attest that the processing facility at Target Marine now meets our requirements with respect to Construction and Sanitation. We are still reviewing the QMP document submitted by Target Marine and they are at least two weeks away from the CFIA granting them Federal Registration but I understand they are looking to BC MAL to see if they can start processing within the province.

If you one of your concerns is if they meet the construction requirements of a fish processing facility, I am happy to attest to the condition of the facility.





Hi Brian,

As discussed on the phone, Target Marine has put in a request to become federally registered. We have been working with them and reviewing their submitted QMP document.

On November 4, 2011 we conducted a Construction and Sanitation (Sch I and II) inspection on their facility and found overall the facility to be in excellent condition however there were a few minor comments. The concerns were the following

- Brush in the back that needed clearing
 - Floor joint not sealed.
 - protective light covering was glass
 - lights in storage area were not covered
 - no floor drain or sill in the washroom
-
- cooler in processing room is > 4C
 - protective clothing should be worn prior to entering the processing room.

A recent inspection conducted on the week of Nov 28 - Dec 3, 2011 confirmed that all the deficiencies were corrected. The brush was cleared, the floor wall joints were caulked, the lights in the processing room are now shatterproof, lights in the storage room now have a shatterproof guard over top, a sill was installed in the bathroom, the cooler was set at a lower temperature 3C and the rack for lab coats is now mounted outside of the processing room.

The CFIA is willing to attest that the processing facility at Target Marine now meets our requirements with respect to Construction and Sanitation. We are still reviewing the QMP document submitted by Target Marine and they are at least two weeks away from the CFIA granting them Federal Registration but I understand they are looking to BC MAL to see if they can start processing within the province.

If you one of your concerns is if they meet the construction requirements of a fish processing facility, I am happy to attest to the condition of the facility.
