General Description of the Incident

Government vehicle was legally parked at the a/n location. A truck headed northbound on s.22 hit the rear drivers side of the vehicle causing extensive damage, and the vehicle then fled the scene. Witnesses heard the accident and upon going out to see what had happened noted the same vehicle come back to view the damage it had caused. A license plate was obtained and police were notified of the hit and run incident. Police located the vehicle and the driver some time later and the suspect was interviewed and admitted to the incident. 
