

**BC Corrections
Violence Statistics
(Jan 1, 2006 to Jan 31, 2012)**

The statistics from 2008 to present are from the Integrated Corrections Operation Network (ICON); and the stats from 2006-2007 were provided by the correctional centre. In 2008, the Corrections Branch began using a new automated system to capture violence statistics. This new information system, ICON, has business intelligence that records and reports violence statistics. The violence statistics are now derived directly from incident reports completed electronically by the persons involved in the incident. The system used from 2006 to 2007 generated statistics that were manually gleaned from a subsequent administrative review of the incident form with the subjective opinion of the reviewer determining if the incident was violent or not. The automated systematic reporting mechanism now in use reduces the number of people involved in capturing the statistics and the opportunity for errors, and produces more accurate figures than the statistics that were manually calculated and reported in previous years.
