Transgender Services Card

- Differing policies at Ministry of Health and ICBC relating to transgender choices on a driver's licence and BC Services Card resulted in it being possible for an individual to have two government-issued documents with a different gender record on each.
- ICBC policies require an individual to be a candidate for gender re-assignment surgery, while the Ministry of Health requires that such gender re-assignment surgery be completed and confirmed.
- Recent human rights tribunal rulings have ruled in favour of people being able to select their gender without the need for surgery.
