Re: Request for Access to Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Justice and Attorney General.
Your original request was for:

Relating to security guard/armoured car businesses: The name of the primary security business licensee, actual head office location, email address, and business phone number.

You narrowed your request on November 29, 2013 through emails with Cindy Kukucska and Kelly Morita to:

Relating to security guard/armoured car businesses: The names of security guard companies and their primary contacts.

Under section 6 (duty to assist) of FOIPPA, the Ministry has created records that are responsive to the wording of your original request. The Ministry has advised that the attached records do not differentiate between “head office” location and “branch office” location. Email addresses are not mandatory on the application for a new business licence or renewal of a business licence. As such, there may be instances in the attached records where no email address is provided.

Please find enclosed a copy of the records created in response to your request. Some information has been withheld pursuant to section 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA.
