The construction tender was awarded at the end of August and project signs were installed on Westside Road in early September. Construction will begin in early October and be completed in November 2015.)
 - Tender award for the resurfacing project (expected to be awarded by the end of September with completion of the work by the end of October.)
- This work is part of the \$45 million the ministry is investing over the next five years to improve safety on Westside Road (this
 amount not yet announced).
- Westside Road is ranked #2 on BCAA's "Worst Roads" List 2014.
