The new conservancies and additions to Atlin Provincial Park will add more than 413,000 hectares to the province's protected areas system.

The legislation will add more than 166,000 hectares of marine foreshore area to nine existing conservancies and 611 hectares of land to five existing conservancies on Haida Gwaii.

Bill 49 also upgrades two recreation areas (Cascade and Porteau Cove) and a

However, they have not helped anyone but to promote their own concerts which make more money from the events, and to generate more donations.

It would be help to share with us, the public on funding information, so that we can have ways to make sure where the fund goes to and helps the ethnic community rather than for special interest groups who abuse the fund.
