

Dear Minister:

In keeping with my mandate as Parliamentary Secretary for Corrections to BC's Minister of Justice, I am currently conducting a safety review of BC's Correctional Service.

I have visited every provincial correctional institution, and I am obtaining statistics related to safety events from the Ministry in order to ascertain how safe both inmates and correctional staff are within these institutions. I will be submitting a report with recommended improvements to the Minister in June 2014.

I think it would be helpful to obtain comparator statistics from other institutional settings. I am wondering if your Ministry keeps province-wide statistical records of safety incidents involving violence or the threat of violence between clients within institutions, and/or against staff members in institutions. These institutions could include hospitals, psychiatric facilities, residential care facilities for the elderly, or other similar facilities within your purview.

Please note that I have also written to each health authority in the Province with this same request.

Any statistical information over the last five years would be very helpful to receive. If they are already in the public domain and available on the web, I would be happy to receive your direction in that regard.

Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
