RiskMaster has been used by the Claims Unit of Construction and Maintenance Branch for a number of years, to manage claims by and against the Ministry.   |
| Nodelcorp Consulting Inc      | Development of Best Management Practices to Address Extreme Precipitation Events that Affect Coastal Regions of Canada | 51,800 | <b>Notice of Intent was posted on BCBid, with no response from other consultants.</b> The consultant has the specialized knowledge and expertise critical for this project. Nodelcorp was the primary authors of the PIEVC protocol required for this project and have experience using the protocol in other jurisdictions. No similar expertise was found within the BC engineering consulting community. |
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
