As requested in your recent telephone call I have checked our file on the reserve of Lot 1729, Range 3, Coast District, at Martin's Cove, Bella Bella.

Apparently I was to get a second consent letter from the owners of Lot 1105 because of an additional 50-foot strip to be added to Lot 1729. The owners delayed giving this consent until we could find out for them the true ownership of the footbridge leading to their island (Lot 1105). It was claimed by some reople that this bridge belonged to the B.C. Department of Highways but they never confirmed this.

It was on our inability to establish ownership of the bridge that the entire business bogged down. If it is now necessary to obtain the consent letter we shall have to start again at the beginning, with a Certificate of Encumbrances and a new approach to the present owners of Lot 1105. Will you please advise whether you feel this is the course to be taken.
