Update on Times of India Film Awards Event, April 3-5, 2013

The Times Group:

9.5m

- Bennett Coleman and Company Ltd. (also known as the Times Group) is India's largest media conglomerate with presence across media segments - print, television, online, radio, outdoor, films and events.
- Zoom TV, part of the Times Group, became accessible to BC viewers in the summer 2012.
- It is owner and creator of some of India's most credible and recognised entertainment programs such as the *Filmfare Awards* (Oscars of India).
- The Times Group will hold the <u>first</u> Times of India Film Awards (TOIFA) in Vancouver in April 2013.

Background:

- In November 2011, the Premier announced BC's intention to submit a bid to be the host venue for the 2013 International Indian Film Academy Awards event (produced by a company called Wizcraft).
- BC submitted a bid to Wizcraft in May 2012 but was rejected.
- In July 2012, the Times Group presented a proposal to BC on the Times of India Film Awards.
- Received Treasury Board approval for \$9.5 million to sponsor the Times Group, and \$1.5 million to fulfil BC's responsibilities (Global Business Forum; Open Act for the awards ceremony; BC commercial; promotional activities.)

Key Messages:

- We identified India as a key market in The BC Jobs Plan over a year ago, and our work to take advantage of their rapidly growing middle class is just beginning.
