Re: Request for Access to Records Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Energy and Mines (Core Review). Your request is for:

Any records related to a proposal by Sea Breeze Power to build an electrical transmission line, known as the Juan de Fuca Cable, to connect the Greater Victoria area of Vancouver Island with the Olympic Peninsula region of Washington State; Any records related to a proposal submitted by Sea Breeze Power to allow BC to access up to 550 megawatts of firm power; Any analysis, briefing notes, issues notes, and emails regarding these two proposals. Date range is September 1, 2013 to [November 28, 2013].
