Under Section 49 of the Forest Act, the parties agree as follows:

1.00 GRANT OF RIGHTS

1.01 Subject to this Free Use Permit and in consideration of the Permittee's covenants in it, the District Manager of the South Island Forest District (the "District Manager") grants to the Permittee, during the term of this Permit:

- a) the right to enter and occupy Crown land in the permit area described in paragraph 1.02 for the purpose of harvesting Crown timber according to the terms of this Permit and the Forest Act; and
- b) the right to harvest Crown timber designated for harvesting under this Permit, for the following purposes and in the following volumes:

20 (250 m3) Western red cedar trees for cultural use wood for ceremonial and societal uses (ie building of long houses and carving purposes).

1.02 The permit area is the land outlined in the bold black line on the map attached to this Free Use Permit.

1.03 This Free Use Permit will come into effect on November 5, 2007 and, unless previously annulled by the District Manager or a Forest Officer, will expire on November 5, 2008.

2.00 CONDITIONS AND CANCELLATION

2.01 In operations carried on under this Free Use Permit:

- a) the Permittee will use the timber harvested under this Free Use Permit only for the purposes specified in paragraph 1.01;
- b) the Permittee will comply with the Forest Act and regulations;
- c) All wood has been previously harvested.

2.02 ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

- a) All timber removed under this permit is to be used for traditional aboriginal use only and may not be sold or traded.
- b) Timber utilized under this permit is exempt from the requirement to apply timber marks as set out under Section 24(5) of the Forest Act. As a condition of this exemption the transported loads will be conspicuously paint marked F07009 where a timber mark would be applied or noted.
- c) Timber cut under this permit is required to have a scale completed. Upon delivery of the timber notification must be made to Lynne Wheeler, Scaling Supervisor, at this office (731-3044) to inspect the timber. Delivery to any other site will require prior scale site approval.
- d) To facilitate internal tracking requirements scaling information must be received no later than seven (7) days after the expiry date.
- e) The agency responsible for removing the logs from cutblock 871116, KM 1800 within the traditional territory of the Huu-ay-aht First Nation shall follow the requirements of the Wildfire Act and Wildfire Regulation.

2.03 If an obligation set out in this Free Use Permit is not performed, the District Manager or a Forest Officer may, without notice, suspend this Free Use Permit, or cancel it, or both.

3.00 LIABILITY - PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY SINCE IT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

3.01 The permittee will indemnify the Crown against and will save it harmless from all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, costs, expenses and losses (actual, incurred, or suffered by the Crown as a result, directly or indirectly, of the permittee's activities carried out:

- a) when accessing this permit area over Crown land including, but not limited to animals and debris on the roadway, loose surface of roadway, poor visibility and site distances, unreinforced shoulders, narrow and twisting roadway, uncontrolled junctions and intersections, and large industrial vehicles.

Under Section 4E of the Forest Act the parties agree as follows:

1.00 GRANT OF RIGHTS

1.01 Subject to this Free Use Permit and in consideration of the Permittee's covenants in it, the District Manager of the South Island Forest District (the "District Manager") grants to the Permittee, during the term of this Permit:

- a) the right to enter and occupy Crown land in the permit area described in paragraph 1.02 for the purpose of harvesting Crown timber according to the terms of this Permit and the Forest Act; and
- b) the right to harvest Crown timber designated for harvesting under this Permit, for the following purposes and in the following volumes:

12 western red cedar/cypress, cultural use wood for ceremonial and societal uses.

Delivery to any other site will require prior scale site approval. To facilitate internal tracking requirements scaling information must be received no later than seven (7) days after the expiry date.
- d) The agency responsible for removing the logs from Cutblock 962219, CE 278/4 shall follow the requirements of the *Wildfire Act and Wildfire Regulation*.

2.03 If an obligation set out in this Free Use Permit is not performed, the District Manager or a Forest Officer may, without notice, suspend this Free Use Permit, or cancel it, or both.

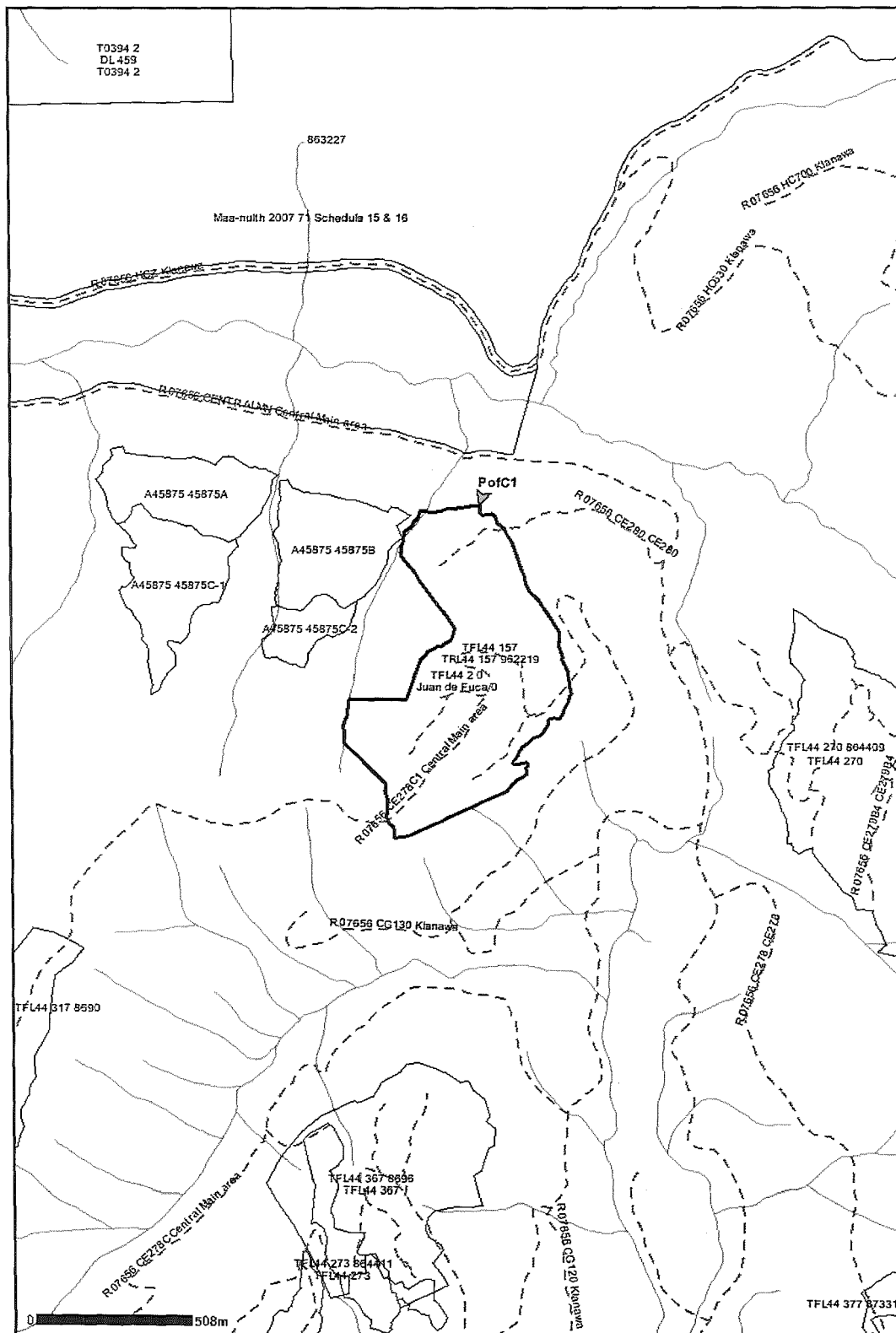

1.00 GRANT OF RIGHTS

1.01 Subject to this Free Use Permit, and in consideration of the Permittee's covenants in it, the District Manager of the South Island Forest District (the "District Manager") grants to the Permittee, during the term of this Permit:

- The agency responsible for removing the logs from cutblock 873118 CR 200 shall follow the requirements of the *Wildfire Act and Wildfire Regulation*.

2.03 If an obligation set out in this Free Use Permit is not performed, the District Manager or a Forest Officer may, without notice, suspend this Free Use Permit, or cancel it, or both.

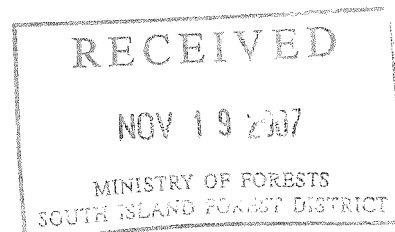

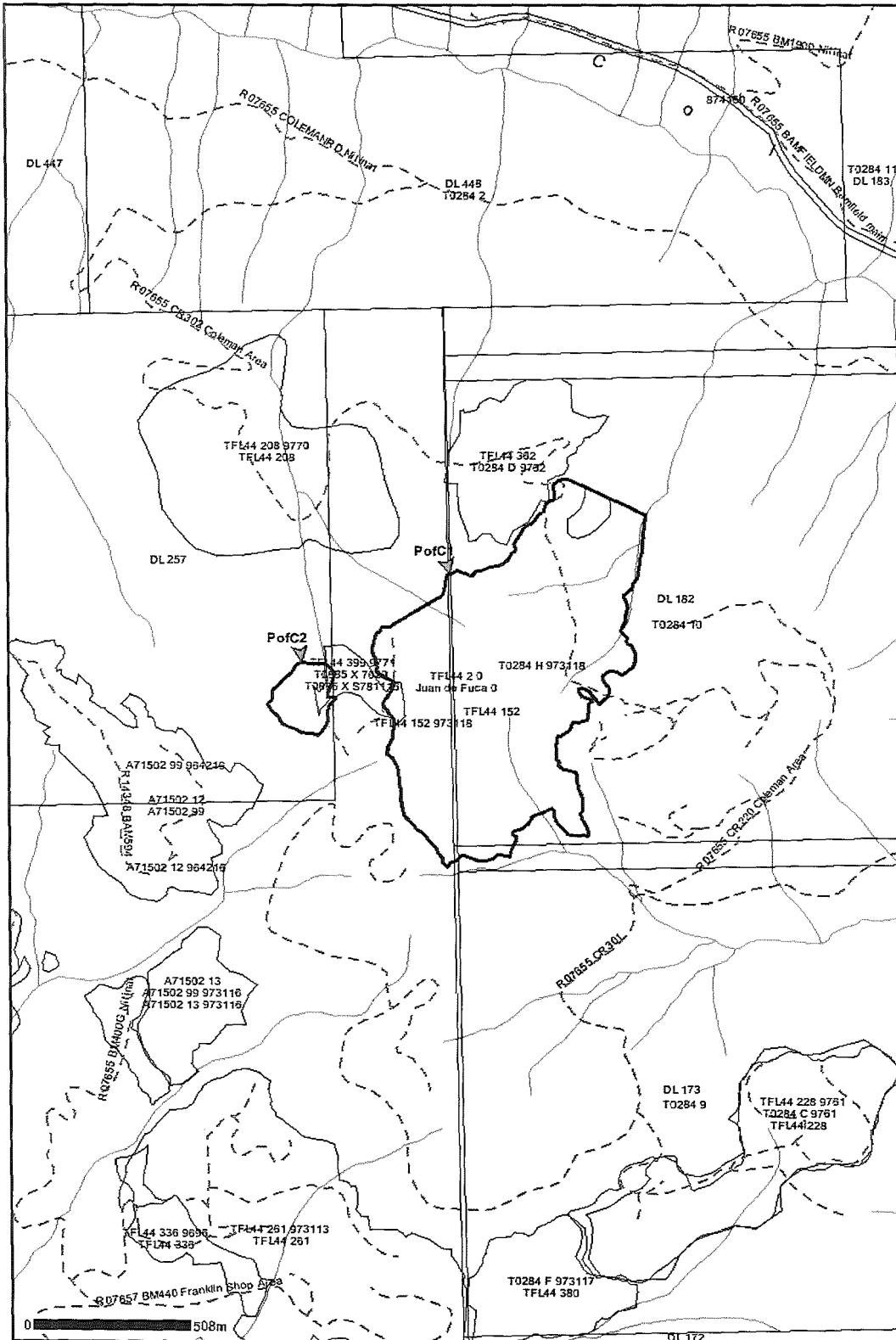
