I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure. Your request is for:

The justification, cost/benefit analysis, budget and related correspondence regarding the Redrooffs Road - Sechelt Area Asphalt Resurfacing Project.

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Please note some information in the records is marked 'not responsive' as it does not respond to the wording and/or the date range of your request. Your file is now closed.

These records will be published on the BC Government's Open Information website a minimum of 72 hours after it is released electronically or a minimum of five business days after it has been released by mail in hardcopy. Maintaining the Province's road and bridge network is the priority of the Ministry and is essential for public safety and economic growth. The Ministry has over 28,000 km of hard surface side roads and 37,000 km of gravel side roads in its inventory.

Each year the Ministry makes plans for a side road resurfacing program within the South Coast Region. Throughout the year, field staff will perform general assessments and identify roads as potential resurfacing candidates. These submissions are reviewed by pavement condition experts, who analyze each submission and perform field inspections in order to determine road resurfacing priorities. Based on the available funding for each year the Ministry then creates project packages and puts out contracts for the selected roads. Through this process, the Redrooff Road was put forward as a \$360,000 project for completion over 2011 and 2012, as part of a \$2,000,000 Lower Mainland resurfacing program.

In addition, the Ministry annually performs data collection on our pavement condition for selected main highways and side road networks, which assists in our overall programming needs. The last time pavement data was collected on Redrooff Road was in 2005 and as such, falls outside of this FOIA request.
