




FIGURE 1: TOPOGRAPHIC MAP OF HOBBS CREEK WITH LOCATION OF CHANNEL HEADCUT







Section 0

This Approval grants authority under Section 9 of the Water Act only and does not constitute permission or consent under any other Act or authority. This approval does not relieve the approval holder of the requirement to comply with any other applicable federal, provincial and municipal enactment. Permissions for access through private or public lands must be obtained. No right of expropriation exists under an Approval. Every person who makes a change in and about a stream, shall exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees, or other property, and shall make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation, or failure of the works. A change in and about a stream must be designed, constructed, and maintained in such a manner that the change does not pose a significant danger to life, property or the environment.

APPROVAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

- The work authorized under this Approval shall be completed on or before September 30, 2001.
- Instream work shall be undertaken only during the period July 20 to September 30.

CONSTRUCTION

- All works are to be constructed in accordance with Figure 2, Project E2102-001, by LaCas Consultants Inc., Consulting Engineers and Hydrologists, dated February 6, 2001.
- Machinery shall be in good mechanical condition such that there is no leakage of substances, deleterious to fish, into the stream.
- 5. Provision shall be made to isolate the work site from the stream flow during the period of construction.
- 6. Any diversion ditch shall be completely backfilled and the area returned to its natural state, upon completion of the project.
- All temporary material, fill, bridge, culvert, pump, pipe, conduit, ditch or other structures used to assist in the construction of any works, are constructed and maintained only during the period of construction and are removed on completion of the works.
- 8. Any temporary approach fill or trestle shall be constructed of materials that are free of substances deleterious to fish.

SEDIMENT CONTROL

- 9. No substance, sediment, debris or material is:
 - a) allowed or permitted to enter or leach or seep into the stream from an activity, construction, worksite, machinery or from components used in construction of any works; or
 - b) allowed to be placed, used or stored within the stream channel.
- 10. All worksite discharges shall be disposed of such that no sediment or other deleterious substance will enter the stream.
- 11. Care shall be exercised during all phases of the work to minimize siltation and to prevent debris from entering the stream; and, where possible, all work shall be carried out from the stream banks.
- 12. Vegetation along the banks of the stream shall be disturbed as little as possible and all disturbed banks of the stream shall be restored to their original condition.
- 13. All excavated material shall be deposited in a stable area above the high water mark of the stream.
- 14. The work is to be suspended if discharge of sediments cannot be controlled.

BANK PROTECTION and REMEDIAL WORKS FOR CHANNEL HEADCUT

- 15. The stream bank erosion protection works and remedial works for channel headcut shall be constructed as per conceptual design of channel restoration within a 16m long reach of Hobbs Creek, as submitted with the approval application and signed by the design engineer on February 6, 2001.
- 16. All works authorized under this approval shall be constructed under the direct supervision of the design engineer and a suitably qualified aquatic biologist.

I am responding to your letter of February 14, 2001, to Sharon Erickson and attached drawing No. 115-2000 showing the proposed storm drain pipe replacement beneath Killarney Road on Hobbs Creek.

Please be advised that the work you propose will require an Approval application under Section 9 of the *Water Act*. I am enclosing an Approval Application Form for your use. The completed form should be returned to our office, to the attention of Eileen Wright, Licence and Permits Officer, along with the applicable fee of \$130.00 (payable to the Minister of Finance).

I would also like to take this opportunity to point out some of our concerns with the proposal you have presented in your letter:

- We recommend that the pipe be shortened to provide easier fish access.
- We have reservations regarding dredging of the pond. Herons are nesting on the pond which has high habitat values at this time. An environmental assessment should be completed.
- The Department of Fisheries and Oceans' (DFO) review may determine that a Harmful Alteration, Disruption or Destruction (HADD), may result from this work. I note you have also copied your proposal to Cindy Harlow, of DFO who can advise you further on this matter.
- The District of Saanich's Environmental Management team should provide input to your proposal.
- The creek splits just upstream with excess storm runoff being diverted to another outfall
 in the park (see arrows at 2625 Sinclair). Therefore, the box culvert would need to be
 set "off level" to allow low flow within the channel.

- The work authorized under this Approval shall be completed on or before September 15, 2001.
- 2. Instream work shall be undertaken only during the period September 1 to September 15.

CONSTRUCTION

- All works are to be constructed in accordance with updated plan number 115-2000 by the District of Saanich dated March 2001, a plan that is certified and signed by a professional engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia.
- Machinery shall be in good mechanical condition such that there is no leakage of substances, deleterious to fish, into the stream.
- Provision shall be made to isolate the work site from the stream flow during the period of construction.
 - Any diversion ditch shall be completely backfilled and the area returned to its natural state, upon completion of the project.
 - All temporary material, fill, bridge, culvert, pump, pipe, conduit, ditch or other structures used to assist in the construction of any works, are constructed and maintained only during the period of construction and are removed on completion of the works.
- All cast-in-place concrete and grouting shall be totally isolated from fish bearing waters for a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours.

SEDIMENT CONTROL

- 7. No substance, sediment, debris or material is:
 - a) allowed or permitted to enter or leach or seep into the stream from an activity, construction, worksite, machinery or from components used in construction of any works; or
 - b) allowed to be placed, used or stored within the stream channel.
- All worksite discharges shall be disposed of such that no sediment or other deleterious substance will enter the stream.
- All excavated material shall be deposited in a stable area above the high water mark of the stream.
- 10. The work is to be suspended if discharge of sediments cannot be controlled.

CULVERT CONSTRUCTION

- This culvert must be designed and certified by a professional engineer registered in BC and constructed in conformance with that design.
- 12. The hydraulic capacity of the culvert must be capable of passing the 1-in-50 year maximum daily flow without the water level at the culvert inlet exceeding the top of the culvert. The culvert must also be adequate to provide free passage of flood debris. If debris cannot safely pass, provision must be made to prevent the entrance of debris into the culvert and the culvert must be installed in a manner which will permit the safe removal of obstacles and debris at the culvert ends.
- The culvert and its approach roads must not produce a backwater effect, or increase the head of the stream.








Schematic drawing of a typical cross section of Hobbs Creek Downstream of Killarney Road Culvert



CHANGES IN AND ABOUT A STREAM Section 9 (1)

A change in and about a stream must not proceed unless it is authorized by an approval, licence, or order; or made in compliance with Part 7 of the BC Water Act Regulations (Notification). This Approval grants authority under Section 9 of the Water Act only and does not constitute permission or consent under any other Act or authority. This approval does not relieve the approval holder of the requirement to comply with any other applicable federal, provincial and municipal enactment. Permissions for access through private or public lands must be obtained. No right of expropriation exists under an Approval. Every holder of an approval, or person who makes a change in and about a stream in accordance with the regulations, shall exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees, or other property, and shall make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation, or failure of the works. A change in and about a stream must be designed, constructed, and maintained in such a manner that the change does not pose a significant danger to life, property or the environment.

APPROVAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

- The work authorized under this Approval shall be completed on or before September 15, 2001.
- 2. Instream work shall be undertaken only during the period September 1 to September 15.

CONSTRUCTION

- All works are to be constructed in accordance with updated plan number 115-2000 by the District of Saanich dated March 2001, a plan that is certified and signed by a professional engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia.
- Machinery shall be in good mechanical condition such that there is no leakage of substances, deleterious to fish, into the stream.
- Provision shall be made to isolate the work site from the stream flow during the period of construction.
 - Any diversion ditch shall be completely backfilled and the area returned to its natural state, upon completion of the project.
 - b) All temporary material, fill, bridge, culvert, pump, pipe, conduit, ditch or other structures used to assist in the construction of any works, are constructed and maintained only during the period of construction and are removed on completion of the works.
- All cast-in-place concrete and grouting shall be totally isolated from fish bearing waters for a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours.

SEDIMENT CONTROL

- 7. No substance, sediment, debris or material is:
 - a) allowed or permitted to enter or leach or seep into the stream from an activity, construction, worksite, machinery or from components used in construction of any works; or
 - b) allowed to be placed, used or stored within the stream channel.
- All worksite discharges shall be disposed of such that no sediment or other deleterious substance will enter the stream.
- All excavated material shall be deposited in a stable area above the high water mark of the stream.
- 10. The work is to be suspended if discharge of sediments cannot be controlled.

CULVERT CONSTRUCTION

- This culvert must be designed and certified by a professional engineer registered in BC and constructed in conformance with that design.
- 12. The hydraulic capacity of the culvert must be capable of passing the 1-in-50 year maximum daily flow without the water level at the culvert inlet exceeding the top of the culvert. The culvert must also be adequate to provide free passage of flood debris. If debris cannot safely pass, provision must be made to prevent the entrance of debris into the culvert and the culvert must be installed in a manner which will permit the safe removal of obstacles and debris at the culvert ends.
- The culvert and its approach roads must not produce a backwater effect, or increase the head of the stream.
- 14. Embankment fill materials must not encroach on culvert inlets and outlets.
- The culvert inlet and outlet must incorporate measures to protect the structure and the stream channel against erosion and scour.
- 16. The culvert material must meet the standards of the Canadian Standards Association.
- 17. In fish bearing waters, the culvert must be constructed and maintained to allow fish in the stream to pass up or down stream under all flow conditions.
- 18. The equipment used for construction of the culvert, including site preparation and maintenance, must be operated from the top of the bank or be situated in a naturally dry stream channel.

Sharon and I were on site July 18th with: Angela Evans and Caroline MacDonald from Saanich; Lena Malmkwist and Patrick Lucey from Aquatex Scientific Consulting; Bruno Blecic; and the works contractor, John Hayton of Brown's Excavating.

We agreed to the following: Work may start earlier than Sept 1st, provided the young Great Blue herons have left their nests and are no longer 'hanging around' Mystic Pond.

The work area will be isolated with silt fencing and/or other techniques.

Water levels in the pond may be lowered 6" (15 cm) below the present levels, to expedite

excavation of the material extending from the mouth of Hobbs Creek into Mystic Pond.

About 50 cubic meters of material will be removed - aprox. 7.5 Meters out into the pond from

the creek mouth, to a depth of about 1 meter.

Material will be excavated from the water with a small excavator, and either 'walked' out to a truck on Killarney Rd. using a Bobcat style machine, or placed into the Hobbs Creek channel and removed from it as the channel is re-designed.

Flows in Hobbs Creek will be diverted through Gyro Park for the duration of this project, and

the channel electro-shocked prior to commencement of work.

This work will be timed to synchronize with the culvert replacement upstream of Killarney Road, so that the creek flow is diverted for the shortest possible time.
