Recently my wife and I had our first exposure to the legal system. A business partner had taken a significant amount of money from the company. We pursued it in court and won judgement plus costs. The defendant refuses to pay the money back so we had to try other methods to retrieve the money. The defendant was instructed to show up at a financial disclosure hearing to provide banking information, job status etc. Unbelievably we were required by law to pay him \$37 a day in travel allowance to attend. At this meeting he provided a pay stub and a couple of partial bank statements and refuses to provide anything else. On the advice of our lawyers we were told to try and garnish his wages. We went ahead with the garnishment in hopes of recovering some of the money. The garnishment order allows us to seize up to 30% of his wages and costs us over \$400. Our lawyers informed us that this order must be obtained for each pay period. The costs are as much or more than we are allowed to garnish. It is like being victimized over and over again. In others provinces the garnishment order stands until such time as the debt is paid in full or the defendant seeks a court order to have it stopped. My question is can the government look into this as I believe it is a provincial matter.
