rkorosal	Zone A would be reserved from new industrial developments through the establishment of Resource Review Areas. The goal of Resource Review Areas is to ensure that a portion of core Burnt Pine caribou habitat is not affected by major industrial development for a minimum of five years. During the review period the habitat would be managed as follows:			
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i	□ No new coal or mineral resource tenures to be issued; □ No new petroleum and natural gas tenures to be issued; □ No new industrial roads to be constructed; and □ No new wind investigative use permits to be granted. Other minor uses that are not mentioned may be permitted (e.g. commercial recreation) if they can be demonstrated to have no or minimal impact on caribou habitat. Consultation with affected Treaty 8 First Nations (West Moberly First Nations, Saulteau First Nations, Prophet River First Nations, Doig River First Nations and McLeod Lake Indian Band) was undertaken as part of the Burnt Pine Caribou Planning process.
