Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure. You narrowed your request on April 24, 2012 through conversation and/or email with Deborah Flin. Your request is for:

Relating to a December 13, 2008 motor vehicle accident which occurred on the Coquihalla Highway, near Hope - between Portia Exit and Great Bear Snowshed. Documentation relating to when the company responsible for maintaining the highway on December 13, 2008 was first notified about the condition of the highway prior to the collision including when the highway was last salted or sanded prior to the collision; Any other relevant documentation.
