Hi Bill,

As discussed in our conversation yesterday please see details of the disposition of waste as explained by Jessica from HAZCO.

1) Waste will be picked up by HAZCO and taken to either:

1) Newalta Service Center in Winfield or
2) HAZCO transfer station in Richmond (13511 Vulcan Way, Richmond BC).

2) If taken to Newalta, it will then be transported to a transfer station in Delta, BC. Please contact Newalta at 250.766.0964 for specific information on how the waste is managed by them.

3) At the HAZCO transfer station, some of the waste will be consolidated, some of the waste is bulked. Waste that is consolidated and bulked is either transferred to an end disposer, used in industrial fuel processes, recycled, or recovered (depending on the waste).

4) Waste will then be transported to either Swan Hills or Clean Harbors' in Alberta to be neutralized. HAZCO does use other disposal facilities in addition to Swan Hills and Clean Harbors (e.g. Photech). Labpacks and loosepacks are generally incinerated. It is not legal to disposal of hazardous waste into landfills in most other provinces.

Re: Assignment of Provincial Identification Number under the Hazardous Waste Regulation

In accordance with Section 43 of the Hazardous Waste Regulation, your facility has been registered as a **Hazardous Waste Generator** based on the information provided in your recent Registration Report. Your facility located at 101 – 124 Adams Road, Kelowna, B.C., has been assigned Provincial Identification Number BCG-06441 as verbally assigned on May 29, 2009.

As a generator of hazardous waste, you are responsible for characterizing the hazardous waste with the proper shipping name, fully completing a manifest form, arranging the transportation of hazardous waste via a hazardous waste transporter with a valid LT license, and for pre-determining a registered hazardous waste management facility to receive your waste.

Provisions of the *Environmental Management Act* [in particular, note Sections 7, 8, 9 and 10], the Hazardous Waste Regulation, and the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* (Federal) and Regulations apply in full or in part to your facility. If your registration indicates that the facility stores more than the quantities of hazardous waste indicated in Schedule 6 of the Hazardous Waste Regulation and storage will continue for more than 96 hours, plans and specifications must be prepared and maintained under section 4(1) & 16(2)(a) of the Hazardous Waste Regulation.

Requirements of hazardous waste generators include, but are not limited to:

- Ensure appropriate packaging, labeling and containment of the hazardous waste;
- Use of a transporter licensed under the Hazardous Waste Regulation with an LT number;
- Fully and accurately complete manifests, which include your Provincial Identification Number as the consignor, the carrier's LT number, and the consignee's registration number;

- Ensure you (consignee) receive and maintain copy 6 of the manifest, indicating acceptance of the hazardous waste at a registered management facility (consignor).
