Re: Request for Access to Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure. You requested:

"All information recorded and compiled pertaining to a section of Highway 5 extending from McCulloch Road and Blue River for the period of December 1 2009 to December 12 2009, including: any photographic images showing the highway or any portions of it; all recorded air temperatures, when, where and as recorded; all recorded road surface temperatures, when, where and as recorded; any and all records of motor vehicle accident; and all incident reports prepared by the Highway Maintenance contractor or by the ministry."

Please find enclosed a copy of the records in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Please also note that weather information is publicly available at the following website address: <https://pub-apps.th.gov.bc.ca/saw-paws/weatherstation>

Please note this information is for the two closest stations to your requested location. Chappel Creek, which is approximately 80km north of wire cache rest stop at 786m elevation. Cleawater, which is approximately 50km south east of wire cache rest stop at 360m elevation. Your file is now closed.
