Storage of 50-100 Lead Batteries in the Riparian Area directly on the High Water Line

I am the holder of Conditional Water Licence s.22 whose licence authorizes the diversion and use of water from Shuswap Lake.

For the simple reason that you issue Water Licences to people who take their drinking water from Shuswap Lake, I expect the Ministry of Environment to monitor the water quality and to warn the population immediately in the case of a threat of an intoxication of the water. On the above mentioned property, owner s.22 you will find a storage of about 50-100 voluminous (1ftx1ftx1ft) lead batteries. Exact storage location of the old batteries: on top of a broken concrete slab, covered partially with boards and metal sheets. This storage is located adjacent High Water Line at the beach. The Sulphuric Acid leaking from the batteries was and is s.22 it did not only damage the environment s.22 it will for sure contaminate finally the water; or might have poisoned by now the surrounding areas. The high water level of this year and the inappropriate storage of masses of lead acid batteries at the high water line will assuredly cause an ecological damage of the ground and water. I request to immediately examine the circumstances and to initiate the necessary measures, so that the population will not drink intoxicated water from the Shuswap Lake. In the case you would not have a mandate to protect the water of Shuswap Lake against any intoxication, I ask you herewith to inform the authorities, who would be responsible in that case and to send me a notice of your mode of dealing in that case.
