Re: Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC) – Order F14-11

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Justice and Attorney General for:

The business case/cost-benefit analysis on the feasibility of the sale (or any other type of disposition) of BC Liquor Distribution Branch warehouses, distribution and other logistics services.

On May 17, 2012 and through a reconsideration release of December 11, 2012, you were granted partial access to records responsive to this request. Information that remained withheld was the matter of an Inquiry and resulted in Order F14-11, dated April 1, 2014. The OIPC Adjudicator has ordered that some information be released to you. This information is provided to you in the enclosed records. You will note some information remains withheld pursuant to sections 12 (Cabinet and local public body confidences) and 13 (Policy advice or recommendations) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
