

(-2.8%)




Month-over-month net change in BC employment, SA

BC's unemployment rate trending upwards


British Columbia, Unemployment Rate, SA

BC income assistance caseloads trending up


British Columbia, temporary and disability assistance caseloads






US Consensus outlook for 2009 has deteriorated 1.1% since January 2009

The chart above represents forecasts for real GDP growth in 2009 as polled on specific dates. For example, forecasters surveyed on May 11 2009 had an average 2009 US real GDP forecast of -2.9 per cent, while on January 14, 2008 they forecast 2009 US real GDP to grow +2.7 per cent.

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

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

Month-over-month net change in BC employment, SA





British Columbia, Unemployment Rate, SA



BC income assistance caseloads trending up




BC retail sales fall rapidly in recent months

BC housing starts falling rapidly





US Consensus outlook for 2009 has deteriorated 0.9% since January 2009





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
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

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Month-over-month net change in BC employment, SA





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British Columbia, Unemployment Rate, SA



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

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BC retail sales fall rapidly in recent months



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
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

US Housing Starts, \$ Millions SA



BC manufacturing shipments fell 17% since September





British Columbia, Exports, \$ Millions SA





NAHB Housing Market Index





US retail sales decline rapidly in recent months






US employment keeps falling in March







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






US Housing Starts (000s; saar)



TED Spread credit risk recently hit record highs





CB Consumer Confidence Index, 2002 = 100





















US Housing Starts (000s; saar)













BC retail sales growth slowing



BC housing market – home sales plummeting






