BACKGROUND: Global TV aired a news story on March 14, 2006 in which a citizen filmed an incident at the Harbour Centre food floor on his cell phone. The incident in question occurred on March 11, 2008 at approx. 11:30 AM. On the film clip 2 officers can be seen holding a male on the ground with another officer standing over the male. The clip does not appear to show any of the officers using excessive force. See following link:

FINDINGS: I spoke with Harry Stausgaard, Vice President of Fusion Security Inc., SBL# B4412, with regard to this matter. He said that his officers were dealing with a person who is well known to them and who continually frequents and sleeps at the food floor at the Harbour Centre. On this particular day, they were in the process of routinely moving the suspect along. According to Mr. Stausgaard (obtained from their supervisor's report), while moving the suspect along, the suspect assaulted one of the security patrol officers and it was at this time, that the suspect was taken to the ground and the police were called. The police attended the scene and subsequently removed the suspect from the area (VPD file 08-44854). There were three surveillance cameras operating in the area. A review by the employer revealed no indication of their officers using excessive force. According to Mr. Stausgaard, this was a routine matter that got taken out of context by the media.

Statement to Press

Regarding the incident that occurred on Tuesday the 11th of March, 2008.

The incident involved an employee(s) of Fusion Security detaining an individual after an assault and refusing to leave the premise for a violation of Complex policy.

In the incident, the employee(s) of Fusion Security followed company policy and procedure in the detaining an individual who refused to leave the premise after being instructed to do so, on more than one occasion. The individual assaulted a Fusion Security employee, was in due course detained, and subsequently turned over to the authorities.

The employee(s) of Fusion Security exercised appropriate judgement and did not place themselves, the individual or the public at risk. The employee(s) of Fusion Security ensured that appropriate back up was in place to facilitate this.

It is unfortunate that one patron who witnessed a small portion of this incident drew a conclusion, without a full understanding of the situation taking place. Given the number of people in the area at the time, it seems unusual that there were no other concerns raised, by tenants, patrons, or the authorities.

This entire incident was handled effectively and efficiently, with the safest possible outcome, and without placing any individuals at risk. This was achieved by following Fusion Security's policies and procedures.

These policies and procedures are specifically designed with the safety of the employees and public in mind. The safety and well being of our employees and the public is of the highest concern.
