Event Summary: Her Majesty the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebration in British Columbia

Key Message: Today, we honour and celebrate her royal highness, Queen Elizabeth on this, her diamond anniversary. Sixty years from now our descendants will look back proudly at this critical time in British Columbia's history – a time when it was laying the foundations of its future greatness.

Action/Visual: Premier putting the time capsule into the Black Rod

Venue Audience: School children, seniors, MLAs and members of the general public

Larger Audience: Legislative staff, general public

12:00pm	Premier positioned on the front steps of the Parliament Buildings to await the arrival of the LG NOTE: MLAs are on either side of the red carpet down the steps
12:05pm	His Honour arrives at Parliament Buildings greeted by Premier
12:05pm	100 person Honour guard, Royal Salute
12:13pm	His Honour goes down and inspects the guards
12:16pm	21 gun salute, concurrent with Royal Salute
12:18pm	His Honour returns to saluting base (First landing of front steps) and is joined by the Premier
12:19pm	Diamond Jubilee flag raising <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lieutenant Governor provides flag to Premier - Cadets proceed to first landing to receive flag from Premier - Premier provides flag to Cadets for raising - RCMP member in Red serge accompanies Cadets to flag pole - Guard of Honour presents arms - God Save the Queen - Flag is raised by Cadets and observed by Lieutenant Governor, Premier and all MLAs from their respective positions on the front steps
12:24pm	Three Cheers "Hip Hip Hooray" for the Queen from Guard of Honour
12:25pm	Final Vice Regal Salute to His Honour
12:27pm	His Honour and Premier enter the Parliament Buildings followed by Leader of Opposition, Speaker and MLA's NOTE: Premier, the LG and the Speaker pause in S15 and are briefed on Black Rod by Sergeant of Arms
12:30pm	Start of Black Rod Event inside the Parliament Buildings (location: 1 st floor Lower Rotunda in front of Provincial Coat of Arms)
12:32pm	The Clerk of the House introduces the event and the participants and acts as MC for the proceedings
12:34pm	Speaker explains how the Black Rod was created and adds third band

12:39pm	Premier speaks to the time capsule, future of BC and significance of opening of the capsule in 60 yrs. Premier places time capsules, with messages, inside the Black Rod capsule NOTE: everything will be handed to the Premier by the Sergeant of Arms as she steps away from the podium and towards the LG who is holding the Black Rod
12:46pm	The Lieutenant Governor provides background of Black Rod and affixes the 1871 gold sovereign from Her Majesty The Queen
12:51pm	Clerk of the House concludes this portion of the event
12:52pm	If time permits Premier walks His Honour back to S15 , and has a brief meeting with him. NOTE: Premier departs at 1pm for Caucus
1:30pm	Start of the Black Rod Ceremony in the Chamber Premier, Speaker and all MLAs are in Chamber <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Senator Richard Neufeld reads statement from the Speaker of the Senate - Black Rod – knocks on Chamber Door three times - Black Rod – knocks on Chamber Door three times more. - Chamber staff member announces loudly "His Honour the Lieutenant Governor requests attendance to this House". - The door is opened by Chamber staff and the second Chamber staff member states loudly "His Honour the Lieutenant Governor" - Usher of the Black Rod bows and procession enters chamber Speaker greets the Lieutenant Governor at the bottom step and the Lieutenant Governor assumes the Speakers Chair.

2:00pm	House in regular session NOTE: The Premier is scheduled to make a statement regarding the Diamond Jubilee as part of the regular business of the house, she will be followed by the leader of the opposition
