I am writing further to your complaints to the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner regarding the Ministry of Technology, Innovation and Citizens' Services (the Ministry) responses to your requests outlined below:

CTZ-2014-00010: All correspondence between January 1, 2011 and [January 8, 2014] between the Ministry and US based companies raising concerns/complaints about FIPPA requirements for data storage in Canada in particular complaints by Rackspace Inc based in San Antonio TX and Salesforce.com Inc. based in San Francisco CA; Any briefing notes, background documents or similar records related to these complaints, including any proposal for amendment of FIPPA.

CTZ-2014-00013: All correspondence, briefing notes and background documents related to a conference call on February 13, 2012 between the Ministry and the Office of the US Trade Representative.

The Ministry has conducted a subsequent search for records in relation to both requests. Records were not located in response to CTZ-2014-00010.
