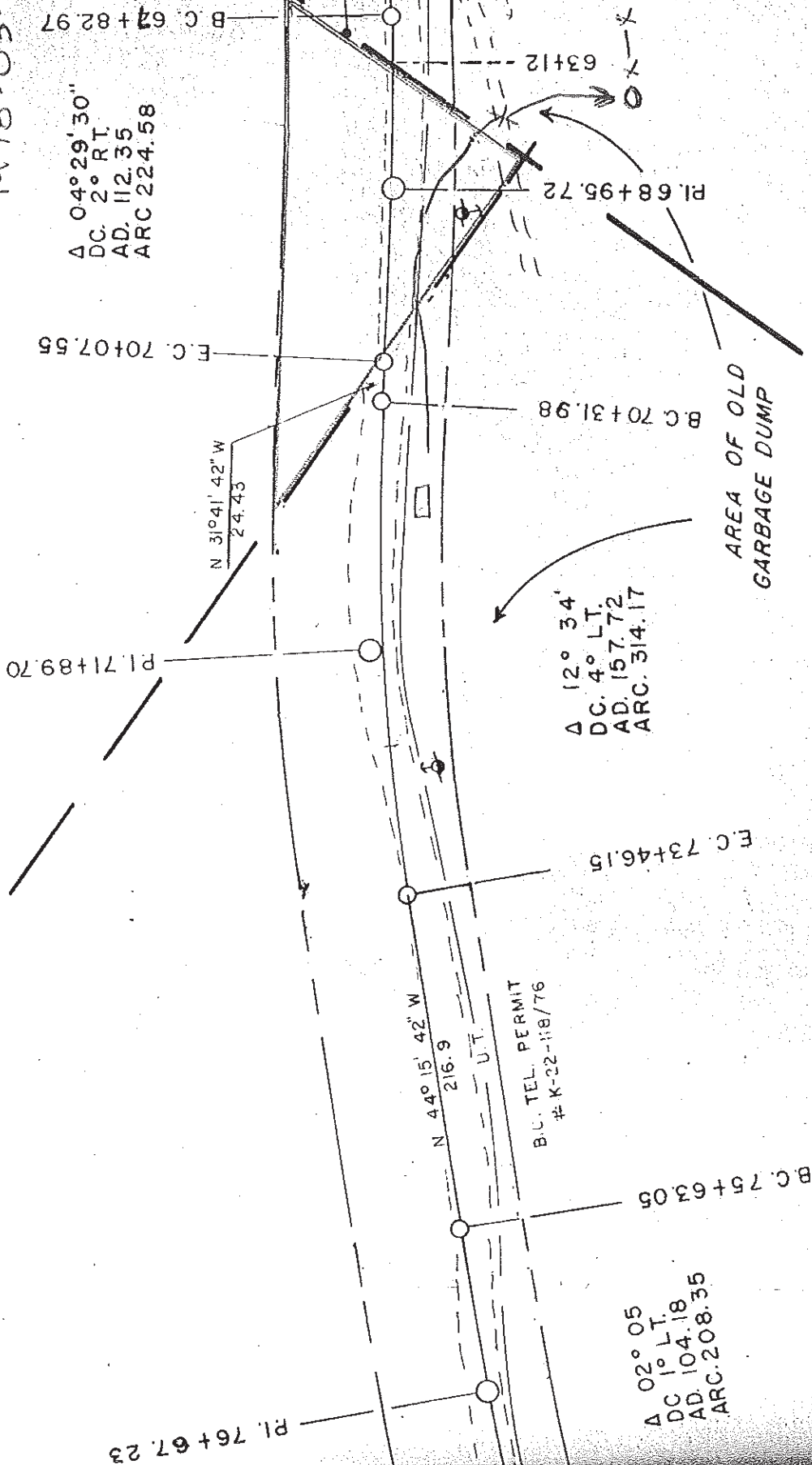

RCMP respond to fatal MVA on Chase/Falkland Rd

Last evening shortly after 9:00PM, rural officers from the Vernon/North Okanagan detachment received a call of a serious motor vehicle accident over a steep embankment off the Chase/Falkland Rd. When officers arrived at the scene, the teenage male driver had already died as a result of the crash.

Two other passengers in the vehicle were taken to hospital to be treated for their injuries. The teenage male passenger in the back seat received nonlife-threatening injuries and was taken to Vernon Hospital. The teenage female in the front seat was taken to Kamloops hospital with fractures. The crash is still under investigation early indications are speed is likely a contributing factor that caused the car to go over the embankment and hit a wooden abutment below.

North Okanagan Fatal Crash - Falkland Boy Dies at the Scene

An 18-year-old Falkland boy died when the car he was driving went over a steep embankment. North Okanagan RCMP Spokesperson, Gord Molendyk says it happened just after 9pm Wednesday night on the Chase - Falkland secondary highway. He says the vehicle went over a steep embankment. The driver died at the scene. A 17-year-old girl in the front passenger seat is in Kamloops hospital suffering from broken bones. An 18-year-old boy from Falkland, who was in the backseat, is recovering in Vernon Jubilee Hospital with non life-threatening injuries. RCMP say early indications are speed was likely a factor in the crash.

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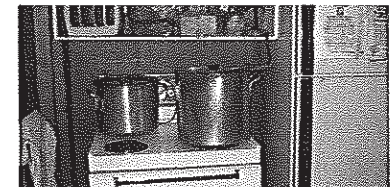

Brief description of the vehicle(s) movement(s) just before and during the collision:

The following description was given to me by Constable Komlos of the Armstrong Detachment who attended the scene.:

The southbound vehicle, which was travelling at a high rate of speed, lost control on a curved section and overcorrected causing the vehicle to roll twice on the road surface before going over a steep embankment. Approximately 8m down the bank the car bounced off a parallel access and then continued down the fill slope before slamming into a log fence on the driver's side.

Sketch of Collision:

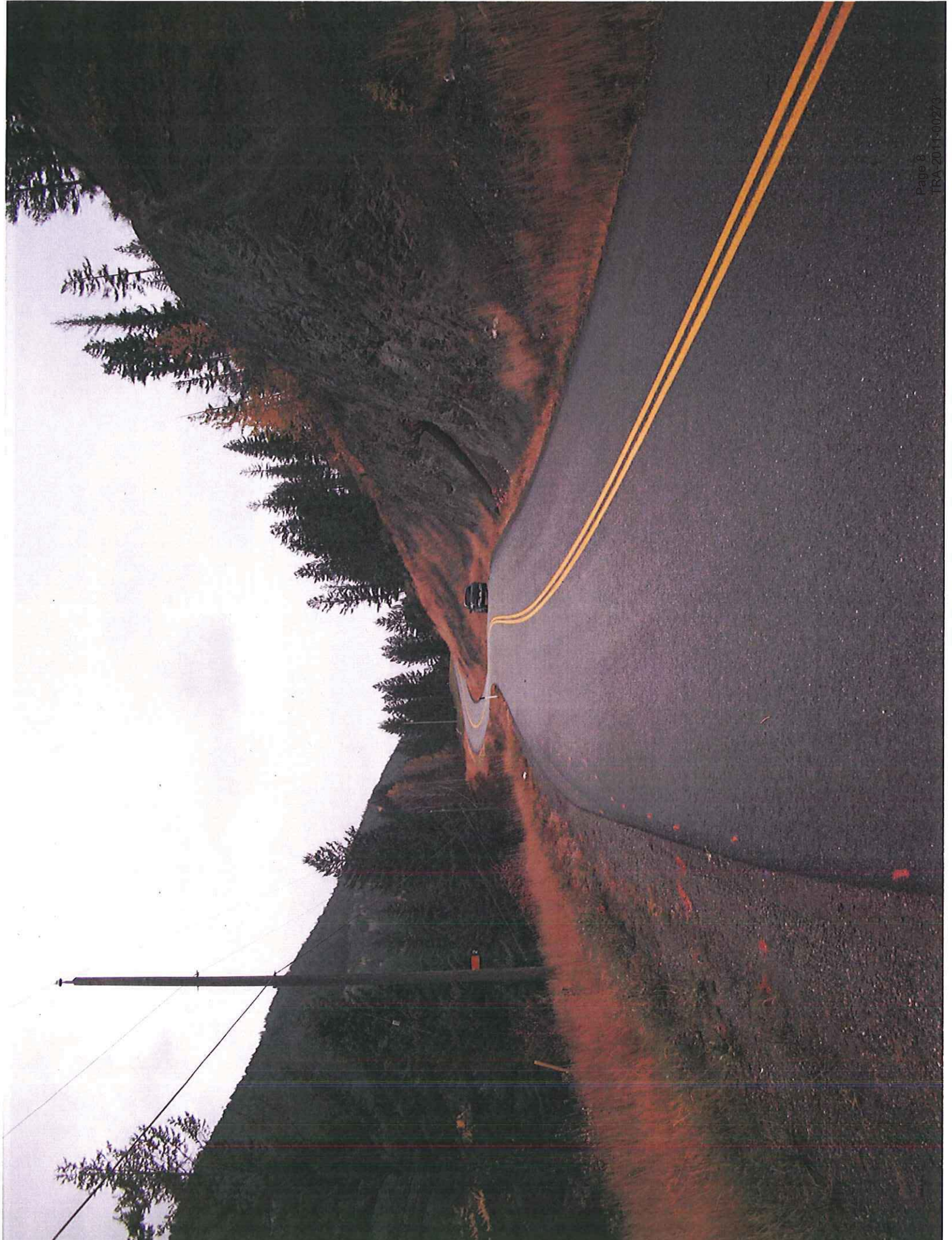

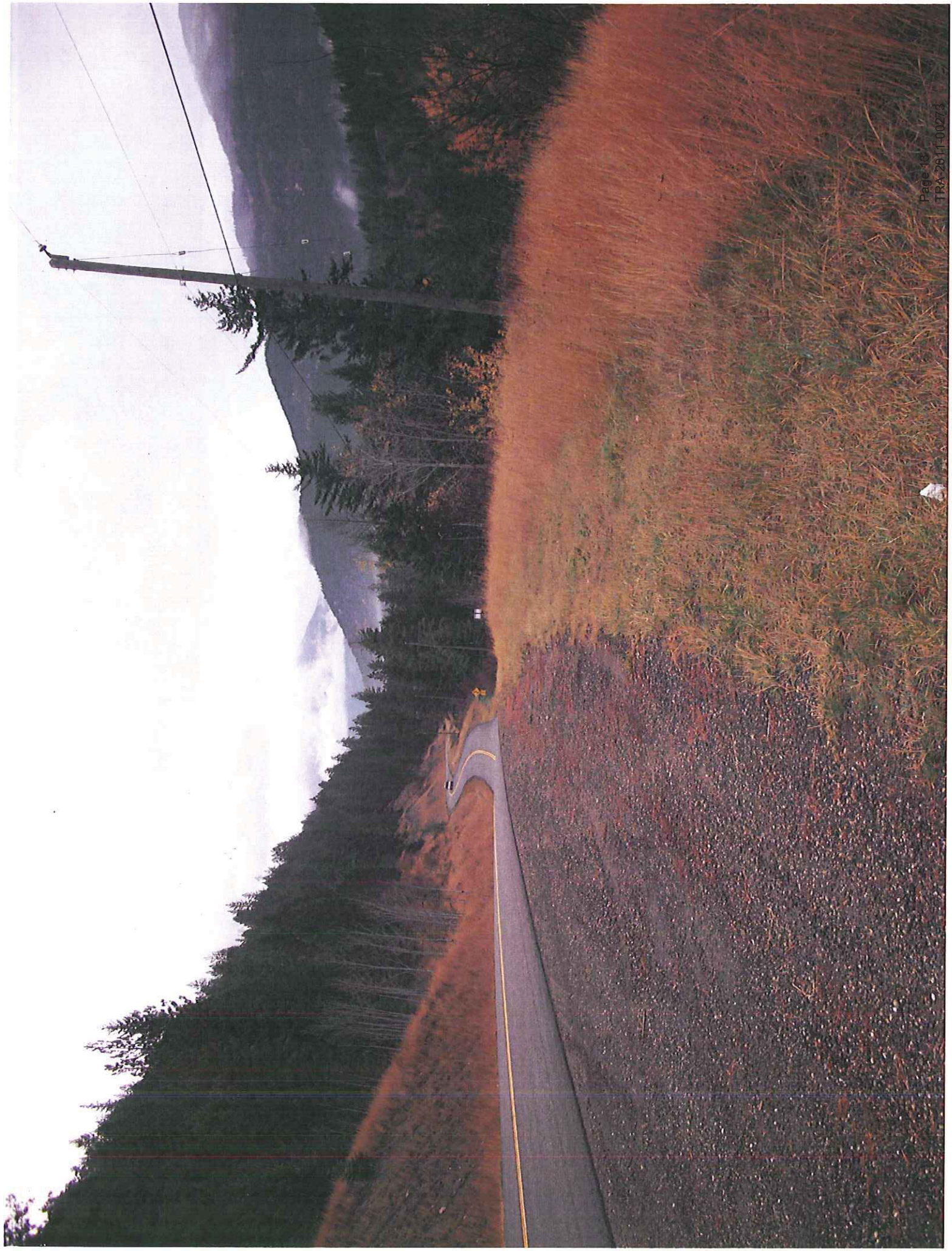


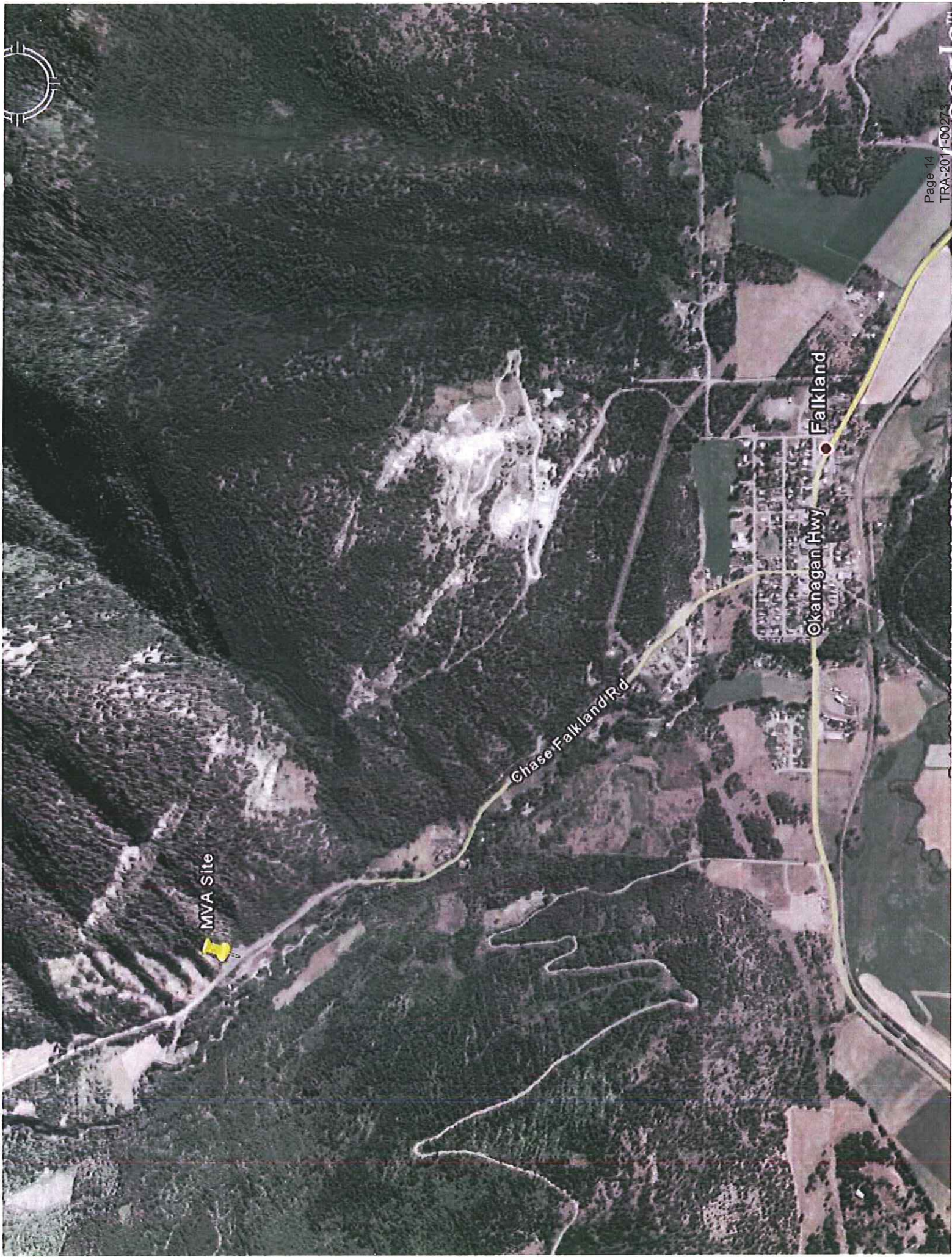














Map of Falkland
