**Re: Amendments to Organic Matter Recycling Regulation**

Dear Stakeholder:

The Ministry of Environment is proposing amendments to the Organic Matter Recycling Regulation (OMRR) of the *Environmental Management Act* (EMA) and the *Public Health Act*. The regulation governs the construction and operation of composting facilities, and the production, distribution, storage, sale and use or land application of biosolids and compost. The OMRR regulatory review process follows the ministry policy of continuous improvement and commitment to review regulations on a regular basis and update them as appropriate.

The ministry's objectives and the proposed content of the amendments are provided in an intentions paper for consultation. A response form to seek comments from stakeholders and the public is also available on the website indicated above. **Comments should be submitted by September 15, 2011.**
