Re: Request for Access to Records Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Justice. Your request is for:

Host Local Government Revenue and Expenditure Reports and Destination Project Development Amendment Agreement account statements for City of Vancouver, City of Richmond and City of Burnaby. Timeframe for January 1, 2009 to May 15, 2012.

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Please note that:

- No "Destination Project Development Amendment Agreement" account statements exist. No development Assistance Compensation (DAC) agreements exist between the Province, BCLC and these municipalities.
- In January 2011 the reporting structure of the Host Local Government Revenue and Expenditures (HLG) reports changed to yearly statements. This would include monies **received** during each calendar year. As monies generated in the last quarter of 2011 were not received by the municipalities until January they will be included in the 2012 HLG report.
- January to May 2012 Host Local Government Revenue and Expenditures figures will also be included in the 2012 HLG report which is due out in 2013.
