## Province of British Columbia *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Tacla Lake.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 21, 2007.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2,273 cubic metres (500 gallons) per day and the maximum quantity of water that may be used for irrigation purpose is 2,470 cubic metres (2 acre feet) per annum.
- f) Water may be used throughout the whole year for domestic purpose and from April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> for irrigation purpose.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A, District Lots 189, 1823 and 1824, Range 2, Coast District, Plan KAP68518, of which 0.4 hectares (1 acre) may be irrigated.
- h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structures, pumps, pipe and sprinkler system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water beneficially used prior to December 31, 2010. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in two dwellings located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

**Re: Conditional Water Licence 122642 – Tatla Lake**

A copy of your Conditional Water Licence and Plan is enclosed. Please read the documents carefully.

No deleterious substances (sediment, fuel, oil, etc.) shall be deposited into the lake; either from instream works or pumping of effluent back to the lake.

Please note the source of your water supply serves as a spawning and rearing area for fish. Accordingly, the protective requirement for Section 30 of the Federal Fisheries Act must be met and it will be necessary for you to screen your intake to protect against entry of small fish. For your guidance, we are enclosing a copy of Fish Screening Directive which describes the screening specifications which satisfy fish protection requirements. Please contact the Department of Fisheries and Oceans for appropriate instream and work methods and timing constraints.

Any error in the licence or plan should be brought to the attention of the issuing office as soon as possible.

If additional fees are required, you will be advised by the Comptroller of Water Rights in due course.

Water licences do not authorize entry on privately owned land for the construction of works. Permission of the affected landowner must be obtained or an easement expropriated. For your protection, permission should be in writing and registered with the appropriate Land Title office.

In addition, permission for crossing roads or lands under the jurisdiction of any Government agency must be obtained from the agency concerned.

In order for you to keep your water licence in good standing, the following must be observed:

- continued beneficial use of water, as authorized under your licence;
- payment of annual rentals;
- compliance with the terms of your licence, the *Water Act*, and any other applicable legislation.

### B. Administrative Details

#### 1. Source and POD

The source is Tatla Lake with two points of diversion in the lake.

#### 2. Reserves and Restrictions

W.L.S has a notation of a restriction on the source as "fully recorded except storage in support, file 0342878". File 0342878 deals with Thaddeus Creek which flows into South Riske Creek, and has no association with Tatla Lake. On a further check of licenses I located File 0342623 which is for a licence is on Tatla Lake Creek upstream of Tatla Lake. This license also has the "fully recorded except with storage in support" restriction. This restriction should not apply to a small consumptive use such as domestic and a minor irrigation withdrawals for a small residential size lot. The restriction should be stated as "storage in support, except for small consumptive uses".

#### 3. Other Licences on Dominant Land

There are no other licenses on the dominant land.

#### 4. Notifications

Consultation letters have been sent to Tsi Del Del, Tsilhqot'in National Government, Xeni Gwetin, and referrals have been sent to Fisheries and Oceans and MOE, Environmental Stewardship.

#### 5. Objections

There have been no objections filed on this application. Environmental Stewardship has commented that the intake must be screened and that deleterious substances are not to be deposited in the lake.

#### 6. Joint Works

There are no joint works.

#### 7. Land Related Issues

##### a. Ownership

The land title document shows that the land is owned by Jackson Sanford Hart and Sandra Lynn Hart.

##### b. PCLs

A permit over Crown land is not required.

#### 8. FN information

An Aboriginal Interests Considerations Report is attached.

### C. Technical Information

#### 1. Watershed Characteristics

The Tatla Lake watershed is fairly dry in nature with an average of 8.5 inches of precipitation from May to September. Tatla Lake lies at an elevation of approximately 910 metres and has a height of land of 1800 m to the South and 1400 m to the North.

#### 2. Water Balance

##### a) Supply

The drainage area for Tatla Lake and Tatla Lake Creek to the outlet of Tatla Lake is approximately 600 km<sup>2</sup> (232 mi<sup>2</sup>) and the surface area of Tatla Lake is approximately 1794 ha (4433 ac). Since the application is on the lake there is no concern on the quantity of water being available.

##### b) Demand

There is only one water licence for 27 acre feet on Tatla Lake Creek upstream of Tatla Lake and this application for 500 gallons a day and 2 acre feet on Tatla Lake. There are rediversion sites on Tatla Lake Creek utilizing water diverted from the Klinakini River.

#### 3. Site Inspection

A site inspection is not required.

- (3) Within ninety days of the posting of the application on the ground, serve signed copies on all owners of land or mining property that will be affected physically by the proposed works or by the operation or utilization thereof, and on all licensees or prior applicants whose points of diversion are at or below the applicant's proposed point of diversion.

All copies must be signed and completed by filling in the blanks in the above form; and, in addition, the two copies filed with the Water Recorder must contain a sketch showing the applicant's land, the location of the point of diversion and the dam (if any), and all land touched or crossed by the works, and the additional information indicated on the other side of this form.

Both sides of the two copies filed with the Water Recorder must be fully and correctly completed or the application may have to be returned.

It is advisable to file the application with the Water Recorder as soon as possible after posting it on the ground because the date of filing will, in most cases, determine the priority of the licence that may be issued.



NOTE.—This sheet need only be completed on the two copies of the application filed with the Water Recorder.

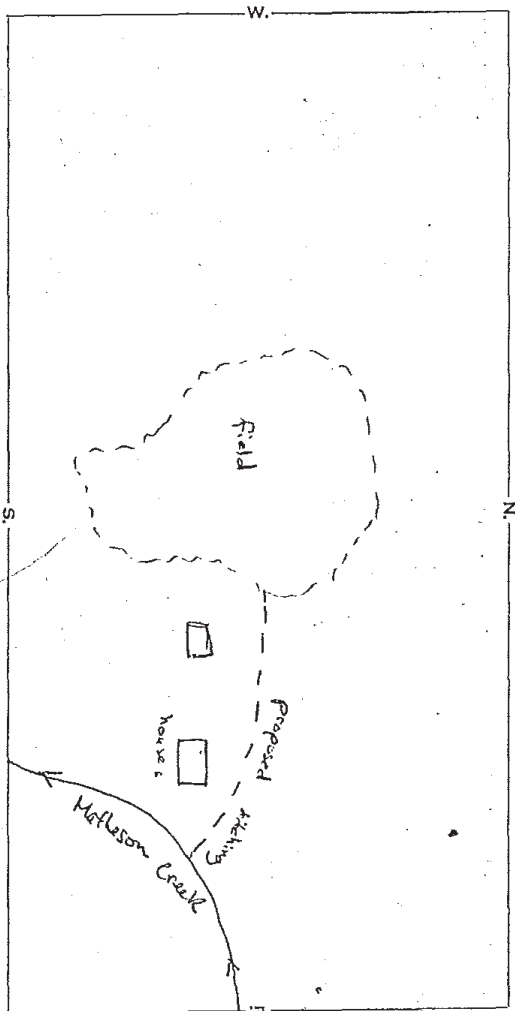

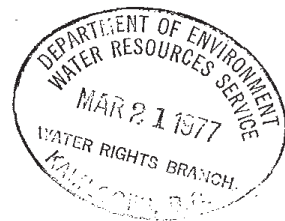
