Title: Funding request from Cherniavsky Junior Club

Issue: The Cherniavsky Junior Club for the Performing Arts Society has requested a contribution to its endowment to ensure the long term support for the "Mr Music" Fund which provides subsidized tickets for children to attend performing arts activities across BC.

Background:

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- The Cherniavsky Junior Club provides subsidized symphony, ballet and opera tickets for BC students through an endowment created in 1967.
- Earnings on the original seed capital of \$250,000 (1967) have supported thousands of school children each year in communities across BC.
- The Cherniavsky "Mr.Music" Fund is administered by ArtStarts and provides ticket subsidies of up to 60% of purchase price, to a maximum grant of \$500 per school.
- Applications are accepted annually in October, and must include receipts for purchased tickets.
- Once applications are reviewed to ensure eligibility criteria are met, successful schools are selected through a lottery due to limited funds.
- In 2010, the \$11,474 was distributed to 57 schools to support subsidization of 4,494 student tickets. Please see Attachment One for the 2010-11 final report.

Families First Considerations: The Cherniavsky Junior Club supports arts experiences specifically for students from kindergarten to grade 12. For many pupils, the ticket subsidy provides the first opportunity to attend a live performing arts event.

First Nations Considerations: N/A

Discussion:

- During the economic downturn of 2008, the endowment lost value. As a result, Cherniavsky Junior Club is unable to meet demand for ticket subsidy requests from schools.
- In response, the Board of Directors held a fundraising event with a performance by Vancouver Symphony Orchestra Maestro, Bramwell Tovey. The performance raised \$100,000.
- Members of the Board of Directors approached the Minister in November 2011 for a one-time grant of s13 towards the endowment.

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Page 2

- The funds will be held in perpetuity with earnings used each year to support subsidized tickets for BC based professional arts performances.
- This is the first time the Board has requested assistance from the Province, and the
 organization has indicated that there is no intention to return for future investment.

2010 Sport and Arts Legacy Fund (SAL)

- MCSCD has received Treasury Board approval for \$3.25m of SAL funding to be distributed to regional initiatives based on approved criteria.
- Funding for the Cherniavsky Junior Club supports the intent of the SAL by providing the opportunity for greater access to arts and culture, and by providing regional access to subsidized tickets.


Dragon Boat Ferry & Tours

It's with my great respect that I am contacting you for the first time. I am the President of the BC Accordion Society and Director of the Victoria International Accordion Festival.

The BC Accordion Society, a non-profit society, was founded in early 2010 in the beautiful city of Victoria B.C. Our mission is to promote the beauty of this wonderful instrument through concerts, workshops, master classes and competitions. In 2010, the Society took over the responsibility for organization of the society 200025

Accordion Festival, establishing an international accordion competition, for the first time in this part of Canada. Our most important achievement so far, has been establishing the accordion program at Camosun College in Victoria. Currently, this is the only place in Canada, outside Toronto, where students can study accordion and obtain an official degree.

The BC Accordion Society is a Voting Member for CIA (Confederation Internationale des Accordeonistes) and as such, we represent Canada in all activities organized by the biggest accordion organization in the world. CIA is the first instrument specific organization to be accepted into the International Music Council (IMC), which is methe largest non-governmental division of UNESCO.

As recognition for everything we've been doing in the last several years we were given the honour to host the 66th Coupe Mondiale 2013 (the world's biggest accordion event) in Victoria, This is the first time the event will be held in Canada.

The Coupe Mondiale 2013 will bring to Victoria hundreds of accordionists and thousands of visitors from all over the world. The cultural and economic impact on BC's summer season will be tremendous. Hotels, restaurants, transit, ferries, merchants and tourist attractions will experience a huge benefit from our festival. Also, a majority of our spectators will come to Canada for the first time and we all know that once they have experienced Victoria and British Columbia, people always want to come back.

I had an honour to represent Canada as a delegate and to serve as adjudicator in the previous Coupe Mondial, held in Shanghai in October 2011. It's where I finally signed the contract, on behalf of the BC Accordion Society, for hosting the Coupe Mondiale 2013 in Victoria. Normally, the next available spot was for the year 2019, but after a year of hard work, we have managed to take over the bid from Holland for 2013. Apparently, the accordion world was just waiting for so many years that someone brings this prestigious event to Canada.

Now we have obligation to make this event memorable for everyone. As a part of the Coupe Mondiale 2013, we are going to host the best accordion soloists, ensembles and orchestras from all over the world. We expect to have around 1000 people with accordions in their hands in an attempt to establish the Guinness World Record for the biggest accordion-performing ensemble ever, and we plan to do that in front of the Legislature in Victoria. That event itself is likely to attract spectators in the thousands!

As you can see, we are working really hard and we have already invested lots of time and money to make this event a success. At this point, we must secure certain financial sources so that we can continue.



Two main areas Maria:

Stages – there were two stages for musical performances, one at Jack Poole Plaza (Nissan Family Zone) and one at Robson/Hornby right outside the Stadium. Pretty much non-stop high-quality entertainment at both venues over the three days of the Festival, primarily local acts. While I was there it was the Naden Band at Jack Poole, and the Kate Morgan Band at the Stadium site. Kate is the young Team BC alumnus and musician who played at the opening ceremonies of the Western Canada Summer Games in Kamloops (her home town). I thought she and her band were excellent, they certainly were well received by all the folks there. These sorts of opportunities (and similar ones at

Canada Games/Western Canada Summer Games) can give young musicians the exposure they need to launch successful careers. If you'd like a list of performers I will try to track it down.

Grey Cup Parade – attended by an estimated 75,000 people (in the rain, likely at least 100,000 would have been there in decent weather) the Grey Cup Parade is a Canadian institution. Marching bands, floats, local dignitaries in convertibles, displays by local clubs, service organizations and performers (e.g. dance groups). I have to say I did not see the parade this year since it doesn't have as much impact on television so I can't speak directly to what was in it this year, but I can probably get a list of participants if that is helpful.

Taking a broader approach, I'd argue that the CFL and the Grey Cup are national cultural icons and I don't think I'm alone in that view. So the CFL Hall of Fame exhibit (very good) can also be considered a cultural display, and the Festival itself a shared experience for people across Canada (in home team uniforms of course!)

The Festival itself hosted a wide variety of family-friendly activities. These included street performers and musical acts at the two stages (Jack Poole Plaza and Beatty Street), activities such as obstacle courses, football throwing and kicking and group football activities on an artificial field on Robson Street, displays of Canadian Football Hall of Fame memorabilia and the Grey Cup Parade.

The Festival has also enhanced its volunteer program as a result of provincial support, with 650 volunteers welcoming visitors to Vancouver and British Columbia. In part, the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games were a tremendous success in promoting our province to the world because of the warmth and hospitality of the many British Columbians who volunteered at that event.

The Festival organizers provided the Province with tickets to a number of Grey Cup-related events such as the CFL Player Awards and the Scotiabank Show Your Colours Gala. They also mounted a reception for Premier Christy Clark just prior to the Scotiabank event. This type of hosting, where a Premier hosts colleagues and business leaders from across Canada is common practice at events such as the Grey Cup, and can also be seen to be an important part of the Province's role in promoting business and investment in British Columbia.



Title: One time funding for the Cherniavsky Junior Club from the arts portion of the 2010 Sport and Arts Legacy.

Issue: The Cherniavsky Junior Club has requested a contribution to its endowment to ensure the long term support for children to attend performing arts activities across B.C.

Background: The Cherniavsky Junior Club was established in 1967 to subsidize ticket costs for children in schools throughout BC for attendance at professional performances of symphony, ballet and opera. Managed by the Vancouver Foundation until recently, earnings on the original seed capital of \$250,000 (1967) have supported thousands of school children each year in communities from Vancouver and Victoria to Kelowna, Duncan and Nakusp.

During the economic downturn of 2008, the endowment lost value. In response, the Board of Directors mounted a fundraising event, with a performance by Vancouver Symphony Orchestra Maestro Bramwell Tovey, which raised \$100,000. Members of the board of directors approached the Minister for a one-time grant of \$200,000 towards the endowment. The funds will be held in perpetuity with earnings used each year to support tickets to BC based performing arts groups for school aged children.

Stakeholder Impact: The program offers on average 6,700 school children from across B.C. the opportunity to attend concerts and performances by groups including the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, Pacific Opera Victoria and the Okanagan Symphony. A higher endowment will increase the resources available, allowing for the support for a wider range of youth across the province.

Families First: The club supports arts experiences specifically for young people from K to 12. For many pupils, the ticket subsidy provides the first opportunity to attend a live performing arts event in their community.

Discussion: The Cherniavsky Junior Club has supported participation in the performing arts for young people for 45 years. As with many endowments managed by the Vancouver Foundations, the Cherniavsky Junior Club principle saw a steep decline during the financial crisis of 2008. As a result, the club is not able to meet demand for ticket subsidy from schools throughout the province. The request marks the first time the board of the organization has requested assistance and the organization clearly states that there is no intention to return for future investment from the public sector.

The request fits well with the arts portion of the 2010 Sport and Arts Legacy in its longstanding intention to support participation by the province's school aged children in the performing arts in their local community.

Title: Funding for BCreative 2012 Conference

Issue: BCreative 2012 is an inaugural conference/showcase designed to bring together government, business, the creative sector, and researchers on May 10 to 12, 2012 at SFU's downtown Vancouver venues. Organizers for the BCreative 2012 conference have requested s13 from government.

Background:

- Simon Fraser University (SFU) faculty members have partnered with key stakeholders over the last two years to develop the proposal for BCreative 2012 (See Appendix One for Proposal Summary).
- The overall goal of the conference is to develop a strategy to further build the creative economy of British Columbia. In pursuit of that goal the conference/showcase has four objectives:
 - 1. To make the case for the creative economy to have a commanding presence in government economic and cultural policy;
 - 2. To inform, obtain buy-in from, and make common cause with the business community by promoting the idea that the creative sector is a dynamic business sector;
 - 3. To convince the creative sector that the sharing of information among the creative sub-sectors can be immensely valuable;
 - 4. To offer researchers an opportunity to bring forward useful information, analysis, training, and research resources that can assist in building BC's creative economy.
- The proposal builds on explicit cultural industry strategies developed and implemented in Britain, Europe and the US, in agencies such as the UN, and in the federal and Ontario governments.
- The conference will seek representatives from jurisdictions with published creative/cultural industry strategies and will aim to put BC on the map as a jurisdiction that is explicitly committed to growth in this sector.
- BC Business Council is a signed-on partner to this project as is the Vancouver Board of Trade, and Tourism Vancouver is helping behind the scenes.
- High profile speakers from the UN and Microsoft have confirmed their participation.
- The Honourable James Moore has been invited and the Board of Trade has suggested that it will invite the Premier to speak at a luncheon session on the main day of the conference, May 11.



Issue: BCreative 2012 is an inaugural conference/showcase designed to bring together government, business, the creative sector, and researchers on May 10 to 12, 2012 at SFU's downtown Vancouver venues. Organizers for the BCreative 2012 conference have requested \$100,000 from government.

Background:

- Simon Fraser University (SFU) faculty members have partnered with key stakeholders over the last two years to develop the proposal for BCreative 2012 (See Appendix One for Proposal Summary).
- The overall goal of the conference is to develop a strategy to further build the creative economy of British Columbia. In pursuit of that goal the conference/showcase has four objectives:
 - 1. To make the case for the creative economy to have a commanding presence in government economic and cultural policy;
 - To inform, obtain buy-in from, and make common cause with the business community by promoting the idea that the creative sector is a dynamic business sector;
 - 3. To convince the creative sector that the sharing of information among the creative sub-sectors can be immensely valuable;

Summary of 2010/11 Expenditures and Outcomes

All of the expenditures met the original criteria of the 2010 Arts Legacy of "enhancing opportunities among all British Columbians in the arts, such as visual art, music, theatre, dance and digital media". Approximately \$3.81 million was allocated in support of B.C.'s established arts and cultural organizations while \$1.13 million supported 48 innovative projects designed to build capacity in the sector. Other major new initiatives included a suite of programs to develop new projects in the field of interactive digital media and a new program that supported 47 new works by B.C.'s most dynamic artists.
