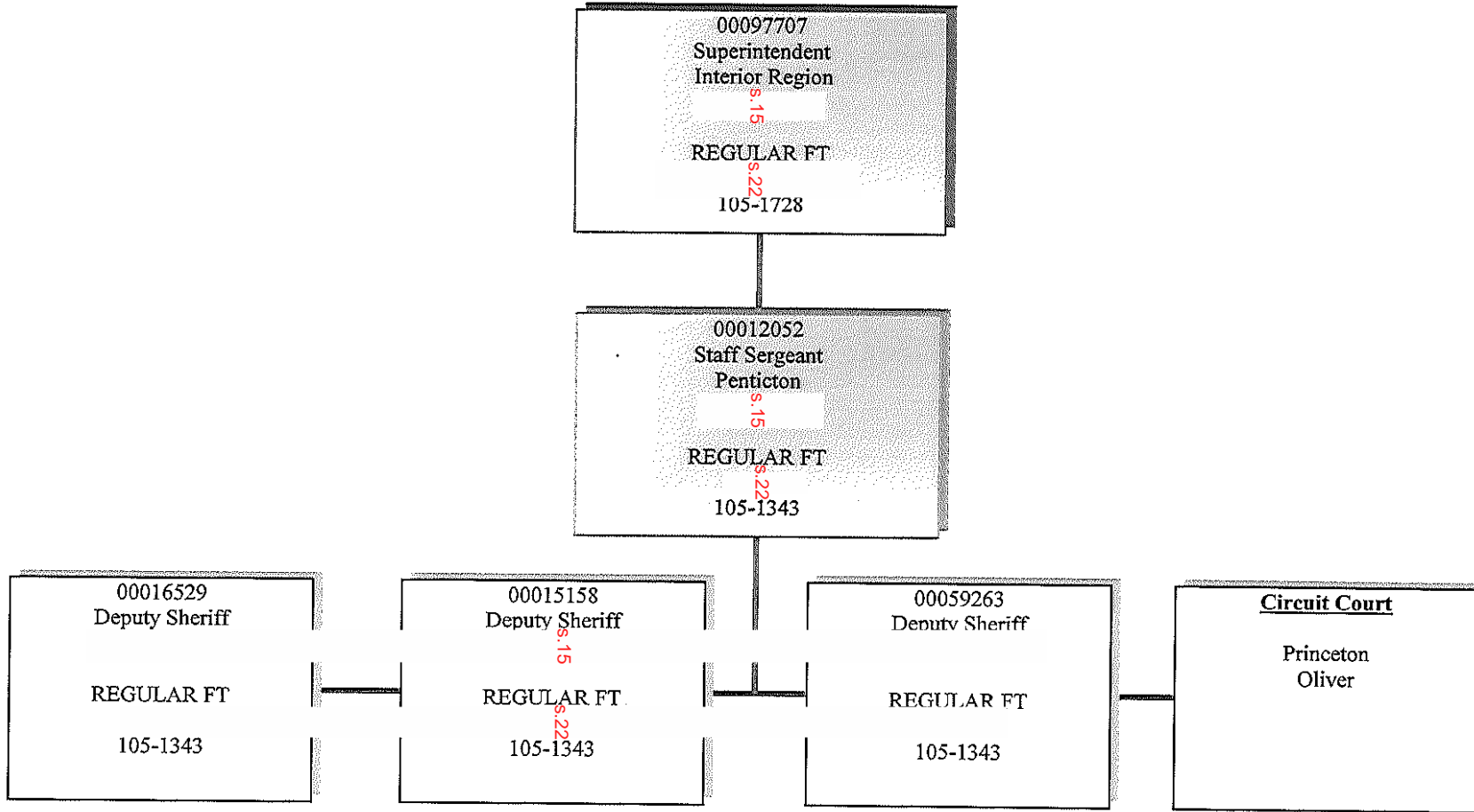


# Sheriff's Interior Region



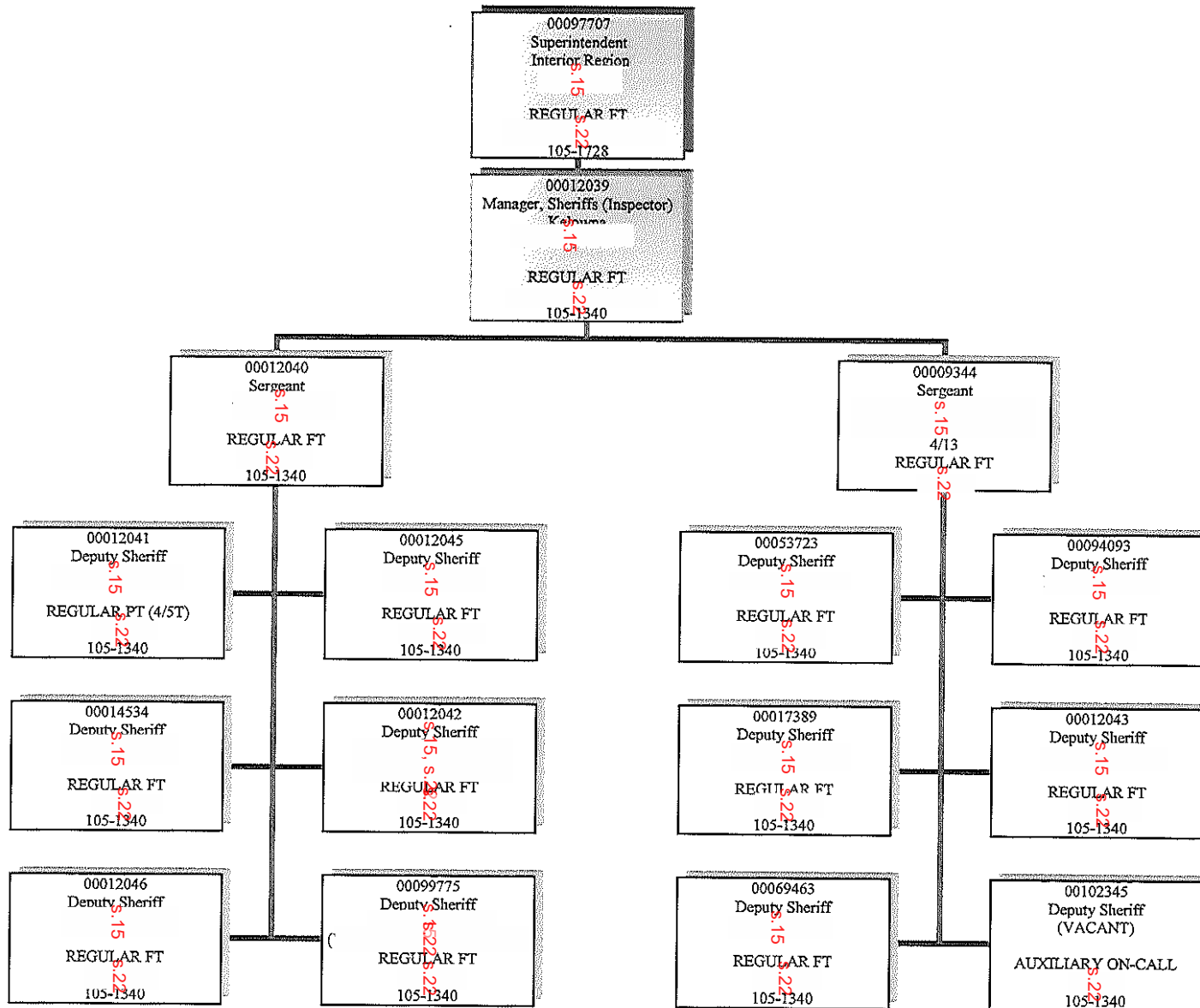

1. NFPC is at the relative geographic center of the lower mainland where a large volume of in-custody accused persons appear by video for their respective hearings. s.13
