

All timber removed from the said area shall be scaled in accordance with the provisions of the **Forest Act** and amendments and regulations. A Regional Scaling Manager, Regional Manager or District Manager may at any time during the term of this authority designate in writing the place of scaling of the said timber.

This Certificate does not constitute any acknowledgement that the above lands are owned by the party to whom the mark is issued or that the said party has any rights to the said lands or the timber thereon.

This Certificate does not constitute any authority to cut timber.

It is the responsibility of the holder to locate all legal boundaries pertaining to the above noted lands and to ensure that cutting is confined to those areas. By accepting this Timber Mark the holder agrees to be responsible for all wood returned to this mark.

The Forest Service suggests you contact your municipal, regional, district or improvement district office to ensure such tree harvesting improvement does not violate local by-laws.

A Timber Mark is **not transferable**.

Unless exempted from this requirement, all timber must be hammer indented on each end of each piece on the area of origin, as soon as possible after it is cut and prior to any transportation off the area.

Timber that will be waterborne or subject to export shall not be exempted from 100 percent timber marking.

Before timber can be exported from the province, a permit to export goods must be obtained from External Affairs Canada.

Where logs or log products are sold, the net profit is subject to a 10% tax under the **British Columbia Logging Tax Act**.

For scaling, marking and documentation requirements contact your nearest local district office in your area.

This timber certificate will be subject to cancellation if these conditions are not met.

Heritage sites may be located on the lands described in this Registered Timber Mark Certificate and are subject to the provisions of the HERITAGE CONSERVATION ACT. The holder, his servants, or workmen causing damage to these sites shall be guilty of an offense under the HERITAGE CONSERVATION ACT and shall be liable to the penalties provided therein. In addition, such violation may render this Registered Timber Mark Certificate liable to suspension and cancellation.

Application For Private Timber Mark

If your private property is adjacent to Crown land you may be required submit a legal survey plan of your property. As per Section 97 of the *Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act* you must ascertain the boundaries. No person shall remove timber from private land unless the timber has been conspicuously marked in the prescribed manner with a timber mark. In addition, timber removed or manufactured from private land must be scaled and the scale site will have to be approved by the Ministry of Forests. This "Mark Site Designation and Application" will ask for specific information as to the planned scaled site and will be required before a designated site of scale is authorized and timber is moved. In compliance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, this data will be used for evaluating a request for private timber mark and is collected by the Ministry for movement of timber and law enforcement, according to Section 84 of the *Forest Act*.
