I am writing further to your complaint, regarding a fee waiver denial, on your request submitted to the Environmental Assessment Office. Your request is for:

A copy of the contract between the Environmental Assessment Office and Pierce Lefebvre Consulting for work on the Ajax assessment; All documents, emails and other correspondence between the EAO and Pierce Lefebvre Consulting regarding the Ajax project.

Date range is January 1, 2012 to [June 26, 2013].

Further to ongoing mediation with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner, the Environmental Assessment Office has agreed to provide you with a copy of the General Service Agreement and its appendices without requiring a fee payment. You will note that some information has been withheld pursuant to sections 21 (Disclosure harmful to business interests of a third party) and 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA. Additionally, the Environmental Assessment Office has already made the final tracking tables and many other documents relating to the Ajax Mine Project proactively available on the Project Information Centre (e-PIC) website.
