Issues for discussion:

- Not all rules/ policies are applied consistently from Victoria
- LPs complain that FP's act like Pubs/ Bars (LPs have lost their 'value' in what their license once held
→ one licence w/ different terms and conditions?
- Inconsistent application of business license structure between municipalities (they use the old form of licensing ie cabaret or pub); different classifications have different hours
- VT's for servers ? establishments are complaining that they pay high penalties, and expect that the servers should also be responsible for paying the fine
- Licensees want staff performance tied to Serving it Right so that it follows them = what type of employees they are.
- Inspectors can compel staff to produce Serving it Right, s.15

- Distinction for SOLs = outside generally get classified as beer gardens with no minors - inside do not. s.13
- SOLs- change from community to community (municipalities) - need a harmonized approach.
- SOLs- need to purchase from government liquor stores, s.15

- How often to liquor inventories get checked – s.13 What's the thought that licensees have to buy from government stores, when LRS' have to buy from government anyways → liquor is still being sold by government indirectly. s.13
