Re: Request for Access to Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Advanced Education. You narrowed your request on June 20, 2014 through email after a conversation with Lise Mino. Your request is for:

This request covers the 3 fiscal years, 2011/2012, 2012/2013 and 2013/2014. To select the Executive Directors that are part of this request, include the EDs that were present throughout the 3 fiscals above (i.e. they were EDs at the start and the end of the three fiscals. This request concerns the Ministry that is presently called the Ministry of Advanced Education and was once known as Advanced Education and Labour Market Development. The number of employees for each ED at the end of each fiscal, or an average across the months or quarters; how many employees (not just direct reports, but anyone working for their branch, including Admins, RO's, Clerks, etc.) were there. For each of the ED's, how many employees (for each year) left the branch for an equivalent or lower job classification, and what their position was in the branch.

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Your file is now closed.

These records will be published on the BC Government's Open Information website a minimum of 72 hours after electronic release or a minimum of five business days after release by mail in hardcopy.
