I would like to question the recent increased salaries of those in the Legislature.

I am a fellow public service employee. I hold a position as a S22 at the S22 I work very hard and cover for three other positions, in addition to maintaining a caseload of over 50 files at a time. There are days when all I do is go home and sleep after work because I am exhausted from this work environment. I don't take sick leave often or abuse any of the wonderful benefits we are entitled to. Also, I make around S22

Firstly, I asked if we are able to hire more staff due to the ever increasing workload at our office. I was told by my manager they have tried twice to get approval to hire someone but were denied due to the hiring freeze. I then asked to be considered for the Pacific Leaders Scholarship Program offered through the BCPSA, as well as reduced work hours (working one day less per week) to accommodate my career goals and to alleviate some of the stress from this high workload position. Ultimately, I want to grow both personally and professionally by gaining and education and a better position within the BC Government with more responsibility.

I was denied both due to spending restraints.

My question is:

How can these large raises to the premier's staff and ministerial assistants be justified when I can't even get approval to take advantage of some of the very benefits that convinced me to join the BC public service in the first place? All I wanted was some help paying for some courses that will ultimately benefit the BC Public Service and prevent myself from burning outat work. I have been looking for other positions but it's hard to find one that's suitable due to the hiring freeze.

Eventually, if things don't improve, I will have no choice but to leave the BC Public Service for somewhere that appreciates and rewards my hard work. There is also the option of going on stress leave and long term disability due to the high workload and lack of support. I am feeling stifled, ignored and very frustrated to be working for a government that does this to its employees. I am one of many in this situation who are so commonly ignored and overlooked.

Please let me know how you feel about this situation and please answer my question in detail to alleviate this perception, which is commonly held by most in a position such as mine, that the ones at the top don't care about the ones at the bottom.


