**Re: Request for Access to Records**

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Social Development. You narrowed your request on July 26, 2012 through conversation and/or email with April Haussmann. Your request is for:

*“All executive reports, briefing notes, manager’s reports addressing expenditures and policy relating to Persons-with-Disabilities and moving supplements deemed necessary because of imminent threat to health or safety. Time frame is January 1, 2012, to July 11, 2012. Alternatively, reports, briefing notes, manager’s reports addressing expenditures and policy relating to Persons-with-Disabilities and moving supplements. Same time frame.”*

Although a thorough search was conducted, no records were located in response to first portion of your request.
