Re: Request for Access to Records - Reconsideration Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Office of the Premier. Your request is for:

All records regarding Premier Christy Clark's planned humanitarian mission to Kenya, which was supposed to begin in December 2013, including the trip schedule, budget, approvals, and costs that resulted because of the cancellation, and correspondence with Free the Children, its agents or representatives, and federal and local Kenyan authorities. Please include the names and titles of any and all people who were scheduled to accompany the Premier.

The Office of the Premier (the Office) responded to your request on April 23, 2014. The Office has reconsidered and is now disclosing some of the information that was withheld.

You will note that some information remains withheld in the enclosed records pursuant to sections 15 (Disclosure harmful to law enforcement), 16 (Disclosure harmful to intergovernmental relations or negotiations), 17 (Disclosure harmful to the financial or economic interests of a public body), 19 (Disclosure harmful to individual or public safety), and 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA.
