On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that:



- 1 *Section 10 (3) of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 244/2002, is amended by striking out paragraphs (e), (f) and (g) and substituting the following:*
  - (e) the impact of noise on the community in the immediate vicinity of the establishment; .
- 2 *Section 40 (3) is repealed and the following substituted:*
  - (3) The dispensing of beverages containing liquor at a service bar must be done in full view of the patrons.
- 3 *Section 67 is amended*
  - (a) *by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following*
    - (1) In this section, "business day" means, in respect of a licensee, a day specified by the general manager as a business day, , and
  - (b) *in subsection (2) (b) by striking out "succeeding".*
