The Port Mann Highway 1 (PMH1) Improvement Project has passed the 50 per cent complete construction milestone. To recognize the contribution of construction workers on the PMH1 to date, Kiewit-Flatiron in cooperation with the Transportation Investment Corporation (TI Corp) is hosting a picnic for workers and their families.

TI Corp is leveraging this employee picnic with a media event (project site visit) featuring the Premier, Minister and MLAs to highlight the project moving past the 50 per cent complete milestone. The event will build upon recent media events/tours showcasing project construction.

Background:

- The Port Mann Highway 1 project includes construction of a new 10-lane Port Mann Bridge, widening Highway 1 and upgrading interchanges, and improving access and safety from McGill Street in Vancouver to 216th Street in Langley, a distance of approximately 37 km.
- Highway improvements also include adding one lane in each direction west of the Port Mann Bridge, and two lanes in each direction east of the Port Mann Bridge, one of which will be an HOV lane.
- The capital cost of the project, including inflation, is approximately \$2.46 billion.
- The PMH1 project will be tolled to pay for the project, reduce congestion and moderate traffic growth over time, extending the life of the improvements.
- Project completion is slated for 2013, while eight lanes of the new 10-lane bridge are expected to open up to one year earlier (2012).
