The Letter of Intent to expand and distribute the IMG-BC Program; All documents including the final review report of the 2008 Faculty and Ministry review of the IMG-BC Program and records identifying options; All documentation related to the basis for determining that accommodation of CSAs would amount to a Human Rights breach under federal and provincial legislation; All minutes of meetings and other documentation relevant to the determination that IMGs should be subject to Return of Service Contracts and that CMGs should not be subject to Return of Service Contracts and the types of residency positions funded by the Ministry of Health, i.e., family medicine vs. specializations.
