Vantage Point is experience an elevated, chronic mortality due to non specific marine anemia (pathogen screening is negative). The total mortality this week is approx 12.2t. We are not implementing any contingency plans as this volume is well within our disposal capacity. I expect the mortality will continue at this level (no spike expected) for another few weeks until all the affected fish have succumbed. I'm not sure how to handle the reporting in this case as we will be seeing the same results every Friday, post mort retrieval. Any advice?

Hi Randy,

I am reporting three losses at three locations for Grieg Seafood. Ongoing non-specific marine anemia continues to cause losses at Vantage Point, RE-13909, the weekly loss as of Friday September 25 is approximately 5.2t. Last week two farms in Nootka Sound experienced losses due to toxic algae and low dissolved oxygen conditions: Concepcion (RE-18364), 57t; and Muchalat North (RE-100245), 33.4t. All mortalities were disposed of through normal channels. There was a delay in reporting of the Nootka losses due to mechanical problems with the Transvac. The fish were removed from the water into vessel holds, but could not be transferred to trucks and biomass estimated until the Transvac was operating properly. Please let me know if you have any further questions.
