I am writing further to your request for a review of severing decisions made by the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations (the Ministry) in response to your request is for:

Regarding DL 13095 Block B in Likely BC: All documents, office and personal notes, phone notes, timber estimates, estimated property values, letters and notes to and from Likely Xats'ull Community Forest Ltd.

Further to ongoing mediation efforts with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner, the Ministry has reconsidered its severing decisions and additional information is being released to you.

Please find enclosed a copy of the records where severing decisions have been reconsidered. You will note that sections 16 (Disclosure harmful to intergovernmental relations or negotiations) and 21 (Disclosure harmful to business interests of a third party) of FOIPPA are no longer applied to the records at issue in this review. The Ministry has not reconsidered the application of section 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA.
