Hello Sandra / Ingrid:

Regarding Conditional Water Licence CWL 065305: [ftp://ftp.env.gov.bc.ca/pub/outgoing/lic\\_images/067500/065305/\(file 200599\)](ftp://ftp.env.gov.bc.ca/pub/outgoing/lic_images/067500/065305/(file_200599))

The water licence includes fish hatchery in its purpose, and the volume is in cubic-feet per second.

WLIS should reflect the water use purpose shown in the water licence.

However, I would go over the licence report on the file with a water technician to confirm the appropriate water use purpose.

The working definition for **pond** is: where water used for floating logs, fish culture or fur farming.

The working definition for **fish hatchery** is: where water is used to hatch fish eggs under controlled conditions (e.g. when water is used in ponds, tanks, or fish pens, for the purpose of rearing fish stock from fry to a marketable commodity).

Yes, if the purpose is changed from ponds (02E) to fish hatchery (02I38), it appears from the rent estimator that there will be an increase of \$ 75.00 in annual rent

The annual rental rate for ponds is a flat fee of \$ 25.00 regardless of the amount of water being used

In contrast, the rental for fish hatchery is \$0.08 per 1,000 cubic metres, with a minimum rent of \$100.00

Looking at CWL 065305, the authorization is for 0.23 cubic feet per second, which will result in an annual rent of \$100.00

### **Changes to Purpose Use Codes**

There have been no recent changes, additions or substitutions to purpose use codes. That is, at least until the early 1990s, where additional purposes may have been added to the industrial 02IXX group of water use purposes.

It is possible, however, that fish hatchery purpose may have been added to the list of purpose use codes after the code for pond has been established.

I was thinking about the PUC here.

From 1993 to the implementation of the new rental rates in 2006 the PUC was described as "INDUSTRIAL PURPOSE Ponds for floating logs, fish culture or fur farming" – code 02E.

It looks to me as if this PUC became Industrial Fish Hatchery – code 02I38.

This led me to wonder if other licences may be in a similar situation of having been 02E and not changing to 02I38?

**Mike:** Could you please clarify for me if 02I38 is a post 2006 code? Was it 02E prior to the new rates?
