Once the unit was completely locked down it was determined from unit and responding staff that a physical altercation had occurred between inmate s.15, s.22 and inmate s.15, s.22 inside of s.15 while inmate s.15, s.22 kept watch. It was later determined that inmate s.15, s.22 may have had some involement in the incident as well. At approximately 2200 hrs this officer, along with CS Vanstaalduien and A/CS Anderson escorted inmate s.15, s.22 from his cell in15, s.2down to15, s.2and he was placed in the 15, s.2dolding tank. I returned to my regular duties as Bravo One where i finished off my shift. This concluded my involvment in the incident.
