

I spoke to the parties involved and they have no approvals. The location is known as s.22. There is 303 feet of shoreline affected. They have dug fill from the hillside and dumped it along the lake edge. There is a lot of fine material that will enter the lake with a rain event, or from wave action. If this is kokanee spawning habitat it needs to be looked immediately, before further damage is caused.

Location is Okanagan Lake, approximately 3 kms north of the Kelowna bridge, on the west side. There are 3 or 4 property owners involved. Only one of the property owners was present at the time. He told me that he was over seeing the project, and takes full responsibility. His name is s.22. He can be reached at s.22. s.22 He lives at the address above.

s.22 would like a call ASAP from someone who can give him direction as to what needs to be done. Right now he has the 2 machines, which were barged in. This cost him a lot of money, so if remediation work needs doing now is the time.

I will need to know if this is spawning habitat, and if so does fisheries support enforcement action. See attached photos.

Jim - this is way to confusing, we are getting two different messages here. We send it to LWBC for there action, and there action to date has been to turn around and give it back to us saying they support enforcement action. So that is the action they are taking, giving it to us for enforcement action. Only we are being told by Rick that we cannot do enforcement action. I do not understand. How can I do enforcement action if we cannot ticket anyone? Either we are doing enforcement or we are not. If we are not, I want to send these off to LWBC and I do not want to see them again.

Today you saw the response back from Duane wells on the Okanagan Lake infill - s.22 He is talking about possible Trespass order and or a Water Act order, and he wants enforcement action. They clearly are not getting the same message, that we are no longer doing there enforcement.

I need a definitive answer, are we or are we not doing Water Act enforcement. If the answer is "not" , then please someone tell Duane Wells and company.

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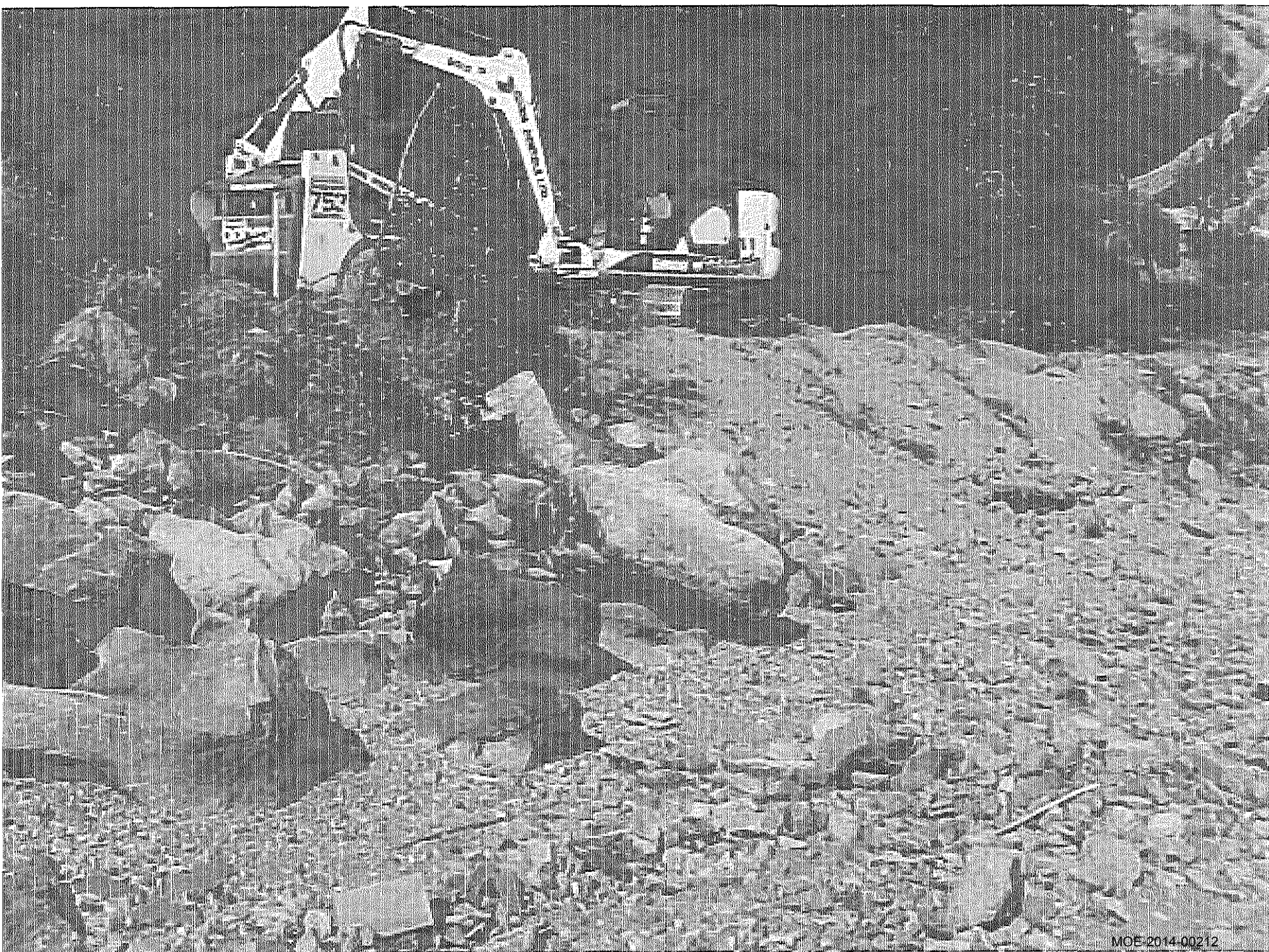

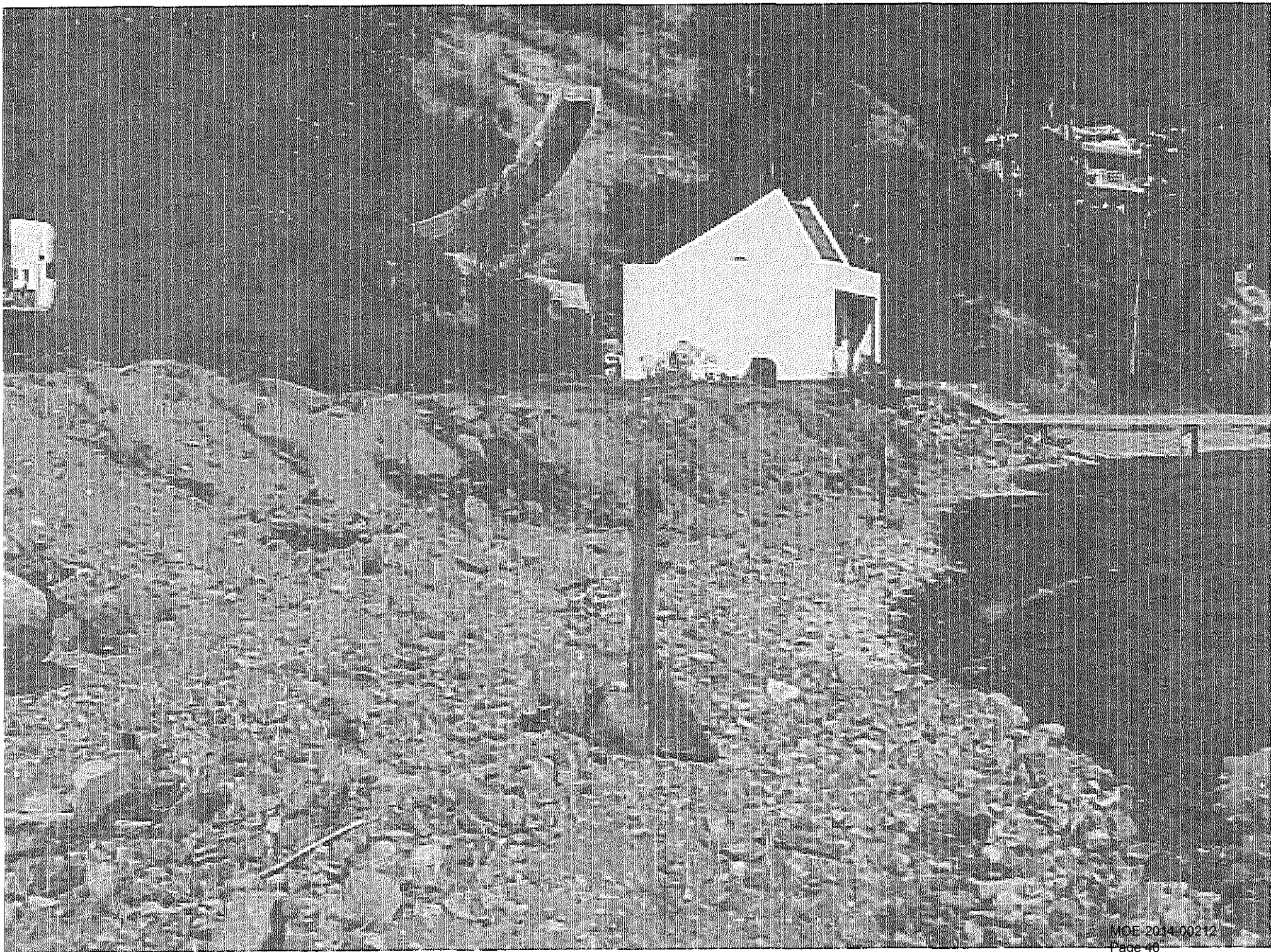
