Process Overview

- **Province received 6 proposals**
- Evaluation committee consisted of representatives from LDB and LCTZ
- Evaluations took place over the week of July 9th, 2012
- Supply chain subject matter expert and Finance subject matter expert analysis provided to committee
- Also consulted with LDB HR subject matter expert
- Committee finalized ranking through consensus on July 13th, 2012
- Stage 2 complete pending satisfactory reference checks on Short-Listed Proponents



Short-Listed Proponents

CONFIDENTIAL

- Short-Listed Proponents list pending satisfactory customer reference checks
- Short-List

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 - - evaluation scores were numerically equal
- Committee and Fairness Monitor determined that should occupy the 3rd available Short-List slot

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DLP Next Steps

- Conduct customer reference checks
 - Reference checks scheduled for after announcement of preliminary short-list to manage communications
- Confirm short-list. Stage 2 of NRFP process concludes
- Stage 3 commences with feedback session to Short-Listed Proponents
 - Purpose is to debrief Short-Listed Proponents on strengths and weaknesses as well as areas for improvement to address in their refined proposal
 - Feedback session is scheduled for the last week of July 2012



DLP Next Steps

- Project activity continues in August allowing Short-Listed Proponents to access the virtual documents room and ask uestions in re_aration for the ro_osal im rovement sessions with the Province
- Proposal improvement sessions with each Short-Listed Proponent scheduled for first 3 weeks of September. Purpose of the proposal improvement sessions is to:
 - Engage with members of the Province's evaluation committee and subject matter experts so as to ask questions, explore feedback provided during the feedback sessions and to resolve areas of clamp, reasonable assumption, community financials so that solid, refined proposals may be produced
- Refined proposals due 1st week of October followed by evaluation of refined proposals. Identification of Selected Proponent is scheduled for October 16th, 2012



Pro_onent Confidentialit_ Provisions

- All Proponents signed a declaration of interest which includes confidentiality provisions
- Confidentiality provisions continue even after process is complete
- Notification to unsuccessful Proponents will include reminder of their obligations to maintain confidentiality regarding the procurement
- Short-Listed Proponents will also be reminded of their obligation to maintain confidentiality as per their declaration of interest



Proponent Notification

- Announcement of Short-Listed Proponents will be in alphabetical order - Ranking will not be published
- Short-Listed Proponents will not be informed of their ranking
- Unsuccessful Proponents will not be informed of their ranking and will be debriefed at the end of the procurement process
- During the feedback sessions to take place next week, Short-Listed Proponents will be briefed, on a criterion by criterion basis, on how the evaluation committee evaluated their proposal
- Scores awarded from Stage 2 will not be carried forward to the next stage - All Short-Listed Proponents begin at zero (equal footing)
