Any and all email records including attachments, generated or received by Don White (Executive Director, Trade Policy and Negotiations) and Robert Musgrave (Director, Trade and Economic Relations), discussing the Province of Alberta's believed non-compliance with TILMA, due to the Alberta Energy Regulator's (formerly the ERCB's) enforcement of oil and gas residency requirements against BC companies and residents, excluding any and all draft materials. Date range is April 1, 2013 to March 20, 2014.
